

God's Perfect Plan for Your Life

What is God's will for your life? You know, most Christians wouldn't be able to answer that. It's something they spend all of their lives searching for. I was in the same boat, so I know it's a place you can get stuck. But what if I told you there's a way to prove what the will of the Lord is?

You might have been told, "Oh, there's no way you can know God's will for sure. You just pray and hope that you get it right." Not so. God has a perfect plan for your life, and He wants you to know it! At the church where I grew up, the leaders told me knowing God's will was similar to the way you'll know the right person to marry. You'll just hear bells ring or something. They said God is just sovereign, and He'll automatically make things come to pass. That

didn't work for me, so I kept seeking.

Then, in 1967, I went with my church group to a retreat in Cloudcroft, New Mexico. At the meeting, I heard a man quote Romans 12:1–2:

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Then he said that word "prove" means to make manifest to the physical senses what is the good, the acceptable, and the perfect will of God. That's what I'd been searching for! It was like God was putting a neon sign on this passage. Most people don't know this, but the revelation I received at this meeting is part of what led to my

life-changing encounter with the Lord several months later, on March 23, 1968. God totally renovated me—and it happened through becoming a living sacrifice and renewing my mind.

The problem with a living sacrifice is that it keeps wanting to crawl off the altar! What a lot of people do when they get into trouble is they'll go to seeking the Lord, they'll run up a white flag, and do whatever He wants them to do. Then, once they yield and God pulls them through, they go back to doing all the things that caused them to be in that situation in the first place. Living sacrifice means it's something that has to be done over and over. It's not a one-time deal.

The Bible says that "there is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death" (Prov. 14:12). You weren't made to govern your own life (Jer. 10:23). But when you make a commitment to the Lord and say, "God, I'm not smart enough to run my own life," then you'll become this living sacrifice that

Romans 12 is talking about. You've got to "trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding" (Prov. 3:5). That's the right choice.

The last part of Romans 12:1 says that this is your reasonable service, or your normal Christian duty. That means it's not just for full-time ministers. God gave His life for you. He loves you! The least you could do is give everything you have to Him and live for Him.

I've had people come up to me and say, "Would you please cast self out of me?" No, I can't cast self out of you. Until the time that you go to be with the Lord, you've got to lay self on the altar.

But did you know that if all you do is become a living sacrifice, that's not enough? The Scripture goes on to prescribe that you not be conformed to this world. The word conformed literally means to be poured into the mold of. In this life, you're going to have hardship. Jesus promised it (John 16:33). You aren't going to exit this world the same way you came in. Life is like a fire, and it's going to melt you. The good news is you get to pick what mold you're poured into. Romans 12:2 says don't be poured into the mold of this world.

For what purpose? To be transformed by the renewing of your mind. You've got to become a living sacrifice and you've got to renew your mind! I tell you, it's both. The Word of God says that if you'll do that, then you will prove—make manifest to the physical senses—what is the good, the acceptable, and the perfect will of God.

These verses transformed my life and helped me learn God's perfect plan for me, and I'm just giving you the highlights. Many people want to experience a miracle. But it often takes a dogged kind of faith to see it happen. AWM partners Al and Angie Buhrke can attest to this.

Through Andrew's teachings, Al and Angie had learned to stand on God's Word, regardless of circumstances. So, when Al fell from a ladder while cleaning an air conditioning duct, the Word was their default response.

When Angie, who wasn't home at the time of Al's fall, saw her husband lying motionless on the kitchen floor, she immediately remembered the verse the Lord had spoken to her two weeks prior: "Be still, and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10a).

She remained at peace and called the paramedics, who transported Al to the hospital.

The doctor's prognosis was grim. He was talking about extensive surgery to repair Al's fractured hip and pelvis, to which Angie responded, "I don't accept that." In the face of the horrific x-rays, Angie remembered the Healing Journey of Alan and Debbie Moore and said, "In fact, my God can heal my husband without surgery."

Hearing that, the livid doctor told Al that Angie was delusional. But the Buhrkes knew that an acetabular fracture, no matter how severe, was no match for God's healing power. In fact, Al held a Bible study in the ER that night, which further infuriated the doctor.

Al was eventually transferred to another hospital where a second set of x-rays was taken. He kept believing he would not need surgery and commanded his hip to be healed. Angie heard the Lord say, "A miracle is taking place right now," and she fully expected to see it.

The following morning, they were overjoyed when the surgeon told them that although the second set of x-rays looked worse than the first, Al was not going to have surgery.

He was discharged and instructed not to bear any weight on his feet for the next ten weeks. But he and Angie immediately agreed that the recovery time would be shortened by

After five weeks. Al decided to visit the doctor to have his hip checked. The doctor looked at the x-rays and said, "This is healing beautifully. Just walk." Al's recovery was miraculously shortened from the initial prognosis of eight to twelve months—with surgery and rehab—to five weeks without surgery!


The Buhrkes experienced a miracle because they decided to stand on God's Word. Today, Al walks normally with no signs of injury. He remarks, "The outcome was a lot different than if I had just agreed with the doctor and said, 'Oh, we need surgery.' I actually have to think . . . Which side did I fall on? That's how perfect I am!"

Angie says, "There would be no testimony today if it were not for Andrew Wommack Ministries. He [Andrew] put us on the right track."


