God Wants You Well Part Two

Last month, I began teaching on healing and how critical it is that you have no doubt in your heart that it is God's will for you to be well. I want to continue teaching on this topic this month and explain **the importance of believing** when it comes to healing.

Most people don't believe they are healed until they see it. This is why many people miss it when it comes to receiving their healing. People pray and ask for healing. Then they open their eyes to see if anything is different based on how they feel, and if they can't see or feel the difference immediately, they think, Well, nothing's happened. I didn't receive my healing. This mindset is contrary to Scripture. Mark 11:24 says,

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

This tells us we have to believe we receive when we pray, and then we shall have it. Now the "shall" might be five seconds, or it might be five days or five weeks. There is a future manifestation, and most people don't believe they've received if they don't see or feel changes **immediately.** Do you know why that happens? It happens because people aren't recognizing that there is more to reality than just this physical world. They think all there is to truth and reality is what they can see, taste, hear, smell, and feel. This attitude is what the Bible calls being carnally minded (Rom. 8:6–7). Most people think carnal means sinful—that you're a terrible person if you're carnal. However, it literally just means that you're controlled by what you see, taste, hear, smell, and feel.

Did you know that everything physical was created by spiritual things? In fact, the spiritual realm existed before the physical world was created. **The spiritual realm is more real than this physical world.** And not only is there a spiritual world out there with angels and demons, but there is also a spiritual being on the inside of you. When you get born again, 2 Corinthians 5:17 says,

> Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Your physical body is not new. If you were tall before you got saved, you will still be tall afterwards. Your soul is not new. If you were smart before you got saved, you will still be smart afterwards. It is in the spirit that you became a brand-new person. In the spirit realm, you have the same power that raised Jesus Christ from the dead living on the inside of you. In the spirit, you have already been healed.

But Jesus says in John 3:6 that which is spirit is spirit, and that which is flesh is flesh—they don't intermingle. They don't automatically merge. Faith is a bridge between what's in the spirit and what's in the physical realm. Faith reaches over and takes things that exist in the spiritual realm and brings them into the physical realm.

In addition to Mark 11:24, now consider Mark 11:23, which says,

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

When you pray, you have to believe that you receive, and then you shall have it. In the spirit, the moment I pray, it's mine. According to Romans 8:11, I've got resurrection power on the inside of me, and whatever my physical problem is, it's done. I'm not going to doubt in my heart, but believe that what I said will come to pass.

I may speak to my body, and I may not feel an immediate change right then, but **if I don't doubt in my heart, and I believe that I received when I pray, it's just a matter of time until what is true in the spirit manifests itself in the physical realm**. But in order to stand like that and believe like that, you've got to believe that there's more to reality than just the physical world. There's a spiritual world, and there are things going on in the spiritual realm that you can't see, taste, hear, smell, or feel.

I hope this has blessed you and built up your faith for healing. I praise God for all the healing testimonies we've received. One example is Cindy Mezas. She now pastors a church, but a while back, she had to take a stand against the devastating sickness she experienced from chemotherapy. 

From Homeless to Building over 100 Homes

Things couldn't have looked worse for JJ Brazelton. One Christmas Eve, she found out that her husband was in love with someone else. Shortly after that, she lost her home in a short sale. **"My whole life crashed before my very eyes. It was like going down a roller coaster ride that never ended,"** she explains. Homeless, staying temporarily with friends and family, she felt alone and in shame as she sat for hours in her car, surrounded by all her clothes and bills. She applied for several jobs only to continuously hit dead ends.

Before the market crashed in 2009, JJ was working as a realtor and had been listening to Andrew Wommack's teachings. Through these teachings, she was becoming grounded in her identity in Christ, but the cares of being divorced, unemployed, and homeless threatened to choke the Word that had been planted in her heart. Rather than give in to the hopelessness of her circumstances, she once again chose to renew her mind using the free CDs available from Andrew Wommack Ministries. They became her survival kit!

"The Word of God remained a fire inside me, enough to keep me from suicide and giving up completely," says JJ. She realized that she had planted bad seed in her life that she needed to uproot, such as the lies she believed about herself, God, and others. She also had to deal with worry and unforgiveness. As she began to walk this out, God's Word began to work, and she started to hear His voice clearly.

While attending a Gospel Truth Seminar in Tennessee, JJ heard the Holy Spirit instruct her to personally hand Andrew a check for the little bit remaining in her bank account, but in her mind, she was struggling to let the money go. Finally choosing to obey, JJ says, "When I put the check in Andrew's hand, he asked God to bless me and prayed that I would receive a hundredfold return."

Within a few days, JJ received a call back from a builder offering her a commission job in one of the least successful neighborhoods in the area. The previous salesperson had only sold two houses in a year! Knowing it would be an uphill battle and feeling she had nothing more to lose, she accepted the job. That's when God stepped in. Within sixteen months, she had built and sold forty-six houses!

JJ was filled with joy and hope. God favored her and blessed the work of her hands. When the company she worked for found out she was homeless, they let her stay in a model home while they built her a custom house at cost!

Today, JJ has so much joy seeing God's purpose for her life fulfilled. She loves building houses and helping to build Andrew's vision with money she never dreamed possible just years ago. She is grateful to Andrew's partners, and she shares, **"I'm living proof that giving free material works!"**

Touching Lives Through Giving!

You may have wondered if you would ever have what it takes to reach others through your giving. Whether you feel called to the five-fold office (Apostle, Evangelist, Prophet, Pastor, and Teacher), or not, your contributions make it possible for Andrew Wommack Ministries to take the message of God's unconditional love and grace deep into the hearts of nations.

Mr Agaba, became a partner of Andrew Wommack Ministries Uganda by listening to the Gospel Truth program on Spirit FM. Here he shares his story;

"Although, I had heard about Andrew Wommack some time back, I became more intentional in 2020 during the first lockdown to download his teachings. At the time, they announced on radio about the Discipleship Evangelism program which I signed up for, to be grounded in the word. What caught my attention as to become a partner of the ministry was when I heard Andrew say in one of his teachings that if one was considering to be a partner, they should pray about it. That

blew my mind and immediately he said that, I didn't have to pray about it. The Holy Spirit ministered to me there and then to become a partner. This was contrary to what I observed was common in the body of Christ, where people are forced to give.

Before listening to Andrew, somehow, I had known in my heart that God wanted me to be a giver, but I couldn't figure out where and how to do it. I had given here and there, in different churches and ministries. However, becoming a partner with this ministry made me realize that I don't have to be Andrew Wommack who has a platform to preach the gospel. When I give, I preach the gospel. I touch hearts and make

a difference by my giving. This is what motivates me to give more. It is all by the grace of God.

After I made up my mind to be a giver, I had a small business that wasn't enough for me and my family. The income was so little that it bothered me, but I still gave. I said I was losing nothing even if I gave. I had given up on my business, but I had to change my mindset of giving to get, to giving for the kingdom. You cannot work for the kingdom when you are not taken care of by the King (God).

As soon as I became a partner, boom, I got the idea to go into making furniture. My business went to a new level. I began to receive wide advertisements regarding my business. Clients that had left me for about five years started calling me for business. I knew that the idea was brought back and birthed by God. I was no longer doing things by my own efforts but with the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Also, during the lockdown I saw God come through for my family. I was baptized in the Holy Spirit and got to speak in tongues. I saw my family transformed. The peace, tranquility, health, protection, provision and favor we receive is something I testify of daily.

In addition, after a brief checkup regrading a serious pain I experienced on my legs, the doctor diagnosed me to have high blood pressure and diabetes. One day I woke up to discover that God had miraculously healed me. All these and many more testimonies I realized materialized after I chose to be a serious giver and partner.

My advice to partners is that they should not take lightly their giving. It is not about mere partnership but a great work for the kingdom. I believe every partner is working for the kingdom, but they perhaps don't realize it fully. But if they can become more intentional and realize that it is all about the kingdom, this can make them become more aggressive givers. There is no way the rewards will not come. This is my experience. I may not be able to go to different parts of the world like Andrew, but through my giving I can reach there. It is that simple.

Time and space would not be enough to share of what God is doing in my life, family, and business just because I obeyed God.

There are many scriptures that address our daily living that Christians tend to overlook. One verse that has always stood out to me is Luke 6:46 in which Jesus questions why some people call Him Lord yet don't obey what he says. Many believers live as though their lives are their own, rather than having been bought with a price. Consider 2 Timothy 2:3–4:

Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

This verse is using military terminology to illustrate how soldiers do as they're told, not as they wish. If you've been born again, then you are a soldier for Jesus, and obedience to His commands should take the highest priority. Why? Because you belong to Him (1 Cor. 6:20).

Jesus told us that we would have trouble in this world, so we shouldn't expect life to be smooth sailing after salvation. But despite the challenges we encounter, God has equipped us for battle by supplying us with His mighty armor (Eph. 6:11) so that we can overcome. Have you ever noticed that there is no armor for your backside? Don't turn and run from the battle. Put on God's armor and confront the enemy with confidence. Our adversary is described in detail in Ephesians 6:12:

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Our enemy is spiritual, not physical. That's why we must resist him with our spiritual armor on. If you're in Christ, you are a victor, and you're instructed to win! Look at the bold statement made in Ephesians 6:16:

> Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench **all** the fiery darts of the wicked (emphasis added).

This is victory before you even start! When the enemy launches a missile of disease, lack, or evil against you, hold up the shield of faith and declare God's Word of truth (John 17:17). The good news about being a soldier for Jesus is that He has already gone before you and defeated the enemy, so you've won before you've even begun.



In 2021, Andrew Wommack Ministries marked its thirtieth year of providing prayer, support, and resources to people all over the world. From modest beginnings in 1991 with a single manager and fifteen volunteers (one of whom was Andrew), the AWM Helpline has grown tremendously over the last three decades.

To commemorate this milestone and honor those who have served along the way, Andrew and Jamie hosted a banquet to rejoice in what the Lord has done. This special evening was filled with warm memories as former and current ministers had the chance to reconnect with one another and share historical highlights and humorous stories.

Former Helpline Manager David McClure recalled how so much of what Andrew and Jamie have done has been on a shoestring budget. "As I was thinking about that," he said, "I heard the Lord say, 'Yes, but My shoestrings don't break!'"

This truth has been evident over the years as God has not only provided abundantly for every need, but also supplied anointed ministers to bless our callers every step of the way.

Some of our current leaders at AWM began their journey as Helpline ministers, including Barry Bennett, now a respected Charis instructor; Andrew Wertz, now Senior Vice President of AWM and Charis; Rick McFarland, now Dean of Faculty for Charis; and Karen Conrad, an entrepreneur and special guest at many of Andrew's conferences.

Just look what God has done with our Helpline since 1991:

- 9,200% growth over thirty years
- 5,677,000 calls answered so far (and counting!)
- Full expansion to 24/7 availability in October 2021

Today, our Helpline is one of the strongest arms of our outreach, enabling us to touch more lives with God's love and healing than ever before. Ministering to every caller through prayer, encouragement, and lifechanging resources has been the guiding force behind every call. We get amazing testimonies daily from people like Linda, testifying to the power of prayer. She says,

I called for prayer at 12:50 a.m. for my husband who had COVID pneumonia. The hospital had just called to inform me that his oxygen levels were critically low. Cindy answered my call, and her prayer, scripture, and our agreement were just beautiful and restored my peace of mind. Receiving bad news alone in the middle of the night can be overwhelming. But God used the Helpline to bring complete peace back to me. My husband called immediately afterward, and God answered my prayer that night. Thank you for the prayer hotline!


