10 Reasons It's Better to Have the Holy Spirit!

One of the most amazing statements in all the Bible comes from the book of John, chapter sixteen. In this chapter, Jesus' disciples were filled with sorrow because He told them He was leaving them. Most people today would feel the same way these disciples felt. What could possibly compare to having Jesus with you? Yet, Jesus said to them in John 16:7:

Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

Jesus shocked them with these words because He was saying that having the Holy Spirit with them was better than having Him there with them in His physical body. How could that be? Most Christians would prefer to have Jesus with them just as He was with the disciples.

Of course, what Jesus said was absolutely true. We have to defer to the Lord's wisdom that it's better to have the Holy Spirit with and in us than to have Jesus in His physical body. But it certainly doesn't seem like that would be true. Obviously, we don't understand and value the ministry of the Holy Spirit as Jesus does.

The Lord has given me ten reasons that the ministry of the Holy Spirit in the life of the believer is more advantageous than the physical presence of Jesus in His earthly body. Understanding this will

hopefully bring us into agreement with Jesus that the present-day ministry of the Holy Spirit is actually better than the limited ministry of Jesus when He was physically present on the earth.

#1 The first reason is that having the Holy Spirit in us spreads God's power to a greater extent.

While on earth, Jesus was limited by His physical body. He could only be in one place at a time, and therefore, He was not always with everyone who believed in Him. But as He was ascending back into heaven, He promised He would be with us to the end of the world (Matt. 28:20).

Now Jesus is constantly with each believer. He will never leave or forsake even one true Christian (Heb. 13:5).

When a person is born again, Jesus comes and lives inside them. Galatians 4:6 says, "God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father,"

Some Christians have a hard time believing this because they can't see or feel Jesus inside them. But Paul said in Romans 8:9, "Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his." Therefore, this is reality whether a person believes it or not. But in order to benefit fully from this truth, we must believe. We have to believe in order to receive (Heb. 4:2).

On the Resurrection morning, two of Jesus' disciples were walking to Emmaus, which was about seven miles from Jerusalem (Luke 24:13-32). They had heard reports that Jesus was raised from the dead, but they struggled to believe it. That's why they were sad.

As they walked, the resurrected Jesus joined them and explained to them from Scripture how He had to die and be resurrected on the third day. They were walking and talking with Jesus and yet didn't recognize Him. It wasn't until they were breaking bread with Him that they realized who He really was (Luke 24:30-31).

If that could happen then, it's even more so now that we can't see Him. And likewise, it is only through fellowship with the risen Lord that we realize His presence with us now. The reality is that since the Resurrection, it's possible to have Jesus with us in our spirits all the time, rather than His presence being limited to a physical experience.

#2 The second reason is that when we make Jesus our Lord and receive salvation, we are born again with an absolutely perfect spirit man living inside us.

There are three times in Jesus' conversation with Nicodemus where Jesus expounded this truth. John 3:5–8 says,


Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

The Holy Spirit is the one who brings this new birth that Jesus speaks of to pass. This couldn't happen while Jesus was on the earth before His death and Resurrection. At salvation, the Holy Spirit seals us so that when a Christian sins, it doesn't penetrate the seal and contaminate our born-again spirit. Our spirits have eternal redemption (Heb. 9:12), eternal salvation (Heb. 9:15), and are sanctified (Heb. 10:10) and perfected forever (Heb. 10:14) because of the preserving power of the Holy Spirit. Praise the Lord!

I wish I had the space to explain all ten reasons why it's better to have the Holy Spirit in us rather than to have Jesus physically present with us. I guarantee the full teaching would encourage you and be a blessing to you. I tell you, we just weren't meant to get through this life without the Holy Spirit. How different would your life be if you knew without a shadow of a doubt that Jesus had already provided your healing?

With only 10 percent vision in one eye and 15 percent in the other, Bianca Vlastuin was almost blind. She had been diagnosed with rod-cone dystrophy, a rare and incurable eye disease that often leads to blindness. At that time, Bianca and her family attended the same church in Hamar, Norway, as Robert and Elizabeth Muren, who are now the directors of AWM's artistic productions.

Bianca was drawn to Elizabeth's Christ-centered confidence and wanted to know what her secret was. Elizabeth told her about Andrew Wommack and how his teachings had changed her life. She encouraged Bianca to visit **awmi.net** and listen to Andrew's teachings.

The first teaching Bianca and her husband, Gert, heard was *Spirit*, *Soul & Body*. "It was a big revelation. And it totally changed our minds and our lives," she says. She and Gert listened to many of Andrew's other teachings as well, including *God Wants You Well* and *You've Already Got It*. "We heard so many new things," Gert adds. "We heard that God has already done everything [we need]."

Bianca then realized that she did not need to have rod-cone dystrophy. She posted scriptures throughout their house to help keep her mind on everything Jesus had already provided.

One day, Andrew's revelation of healing fully became hers. "I was sitting and reading the Bible. Then I realized that what I have [in Jesus] is so

amazing. And I started to praise God for it. I thanked Him for everything He's done, that He didn't need to do anything to heal me, and that He already did it at the cross."

Bianca then started speaking to her eyes, as she'd learned from Andrew. She said, "Eyes, you were healed in the name of Jesus, so you must see now!" Her vision fluctuated. But she continued praising God for her healing and speaking to her eyes until she could see clearly.

Thrilled with the realization that she would now be able to see Gert, she drove to his office and shared the good news with him. They were both elated. The devil tried to steal her healing a couple of times after, but she would shout, "No! . . . I am healed, so eyes, you must see in Jesus' name." Her vision is now perfect!

To help others learn the truth of the Gospel, Bianca and Gert started sharing Andrew's teachings with their church on Tuesdays. They also shared Andrew's teachings with a struggling young lady who was staying with them. She got born again within three weeks and enrolled at Charis Belfast shortly after.

Additionally, while watching Andrew's program, Bianca and Gert were inspired to start a ministry to help young women choose life instead of abortion.

We know from Scripture that Satan has schemes (2 Cor. 2:11, New American Standard Bible). A scheme is a well-designed, well-thought-out plan to destroy you. Unfortunately, Christians can get caught up in the enemy's schemes. One scheme that traps many people is unforgiveness, and that's what I want to focus on. Forgiveness is commanded by God. Matthew 18:21–22 says,

Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times? Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

Jesus was not saying to stop forgiving after 490 times, but to **always forgive**. Jesus goes on in Matthew 18:23–35 to tell the parable of a servant who is forgiven of his debt by his master, yet he has no compassion to forgive those who owe him. Jesus said the unforgiving servant would be delivered unto tormenters, and the same will be done to us if we don't forgive. God releases you to the consequences of your sin.

When you don't forgive others, Satan has a legal right to be in your life, and he'll bring things you don't want. Unforgiveness invites Satan into our lives to torment us. The enemy will help you make the case against the person who offended you. People will fight for

their right to be offended, yet it tortures them.

We forgive because Jesus forgave us. People will hurt you, but there is no justification for unforgiveness. You may wonder how to truly forgive someone after they've hurt you. The answer is to separate your soul from your spirit. The real problem is your unrenewed mind. When offense comes, we're not prepared to stand against it.

Too many people default to responding out of their souls. The only part of you that is renewed when you're born again is your spirit. You forgive someone by making the choice to forgive, not by how you feel. Matthew 26:41 tells us that the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak. You need to use the part of you that is willing—your born-again spirit—to make the choice to forgive. Though you've suffered and been hurt, when you practice forgiveness, in time you will be strengthened, settled, and established (1 Pet. 5:10).

God's grace will do amazing things in your life. Don't get caught up in Satan's scheme of unforgiveness. Make the decision through your born-again spirit to forgive, and you will be blessed.
