The Old Man Is Dead

Last year, I taught on the book of Romans and addressed a variety of topics, including the fact that the old man is dead (Rom. 6:6). But the Lord told me to make a whole teaching specifically about the old man so that people could really understand it.

There are a lot of people who use terminology about their old man being dead, yet they find that it "resurrects" every morning. That's because they're still identifying with having a fallen sinful nature. That is detrimental to Christian growth.

The Scripture says, in Proverbs 23:7, "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he." If you think you're still dead in trespasses and sins—and that you've also got a new nature—then you're schizophrenic. It's just a matter of time until that old nature dominates you because that's who you think you are.

But that shouldn't be the case for any born-again child of God. You don't have a part of you that's separated from God. If you're born again, your nature has been completely changed! The only thing still compelling you to live the way you did before you got born again is the fact that you haven't renewed your mind.

When I first started ministering, I had some time to minister in the local jails. I recall talking with one of the men through the bars. I was saying, "If I had the power to free you, and I just opened the door and said, 'You're free!' you'd be freed. But that doesn't mean you'd be free. You have to believe you're free and then act on it by getting off your bunk and walking out the door."

A similar thing happened when Abraham Lincoln announced the emancipation of slaves in 1863. The Confederate States didn't think it applied to them, so they didn't even tell their slaves about the Emancipation Proclamation. Then, on June 19, 1865, these Texas slaves heard from Union soldiers that they had been freed over two years earlier. Imagine how they must've felt hearing that they had been free all along—they just didn't know it.

The same concept applies to us. Jesus has totally set us free. When we were born again, the old man died with Christ. Born-again believers do not have a sinful nature (Rom. 6:6–7). We've been freed! But if you somehow or another still believe that you are by nature a sinner, then you'll still let that sin nature influence you.

It is because the old man is dead in the believer that Paul can give the exhortation in Romans 6:12, "Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof." The word therefore means it's referring to the previous things that were said—which is that your old man is dead. And because you are no longer enslaved to the old man, you can do what

Romans 6:13 says:

Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

This is an awesome truth, yet it's contrary to most religious teaching. That doesn't make it wrong though. You just have to renew your mind. Part of renewing your mind is reckoning yourself to be dead in the same way that Christ is dead unto sin (Rom. 6:11).

Jesus only died unto sin once, and you only die unto that old sin nature one time. The Bible says your old man is dead, and it does not resurrect every morning. If you really understood that it's not your nature to live in sin anymore, then you would be free from sin.

First Peter 5:8 says that Satan is going about as a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour. He can't devour just anybody. You have to cooperate with him through unbelief—through sin—in order to give him that inroad into your life.

Look at Romans 6:17 where it says, "But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you." That word "servants" here comes from the Greek word doulos, and it means "slave" (Strong's Exhaustive Concordance).

Before you were born again, you were a slave to sin and couldn't consistently resist it. You might have done some good things, but consistently, you were living as a sinner because that was your nature. You were enslaved to sin. But now you've been set free from that enslavement!

Most people don't have this mindset. But the truth is that when you get born again, God puts His nature on the inside of you—and you are married to that nature. If you would just renew your mind and change that old man's programming, this new nature would compel you to live a holy life, just as your old sinful nature compelled you to live a sinful life.

Boy, this is really simple—but that's exactly what the Bible says. These are some of the most foundational, liberating things that you could ever learn. And I'm not saying that because it's my teaching. It's just truth!



August 23, 2002 ... in the city of Kampala. At the livestream center organized in the premises of Andrew Wommack Ministries and Charis Bible College Uganda, Mr. Kironde shared an interesting testimony of the great wonders of God in his life and family.

Frank is a Ugandan and lives in Kampala. He has been a Christian since his childhood. Between 2008/2009, Frank got to hear about Andrew Wommack. He had left home to the village to live with a friend of his. He was so hungry for the word that he began to devour all of Andrew's teachings, both audios and books. He kept on soaking himself in the teachings repeatedly until he began to experience a faster growth in his life.

According to him, 'when I went to the Andrew Wommack Ministries website. I found an ocean of materials and resources that transformed my life.'Thus, he ended up making Andrew his professor.

His questions began to be answered, things began to make sense to him. He began to live and practice the principles of the bible as taught by

Andrew... His philosophy about life changed.

When he came back to Kampala, he decided to visit Andrew Wommack Ministries bookstore where he was given a free CD on the **power of** partnership. He listened to the CD and he discovered the need for him to become deliberate in his giving and sowing to the ministry. In addition, he listened to another teaching by Andrew on giving where you are fed. This was a jumpstart for him. From then onwards, he became an intentional giver ... and his income grew.

One of the major impacts that took place in his life was in the aspect of speaking and praying in tongues. Himself and his friend began a fellowship, but it was a zeal without knowledge. But after reading Andrew's book on "The New You and The Holy Spirit", things changed about his prayer life. Now when he prays, 90% of his prayer is in tongues because he prays the will of God. This is how he draws wisdom on things pertaining to his life.

Another major impact is in partnership. He and his wife reached a point where they needed to

enlarge their income. His wife was interested in the food industry, however, there was not enough money to start the business and even secure a place for it. So, what they did was to give the money they had raised to the ministry. It was a big amount for them at the time. After giving the money, they were full of joy. They knew that what they had believed God for would materialize. Fast forward, a year later, God miraculously supplied the money to rent the place for the business. What is interesting is that at the time when businesses were closing because of the effect of the Covid-19 pandemic and the country opening from lockdown, their business kicked off and was flourishing. This was something they had failed to start for a very long time even when things were going on well for them. It was exciting to see a dream come true.

Today, Frank is an employer. He is glad to be part of people's lives. He engages in the facilitation of the Discipleship Evangelism program within his sphere of influence. In addition to that, he is involved in a fund where he takes care of several orphans. God is doing great things through him, touching many lives that encounter him.

Frank said: "I am happy to see the excellence in the ministry, the changes in the facility and the expansion going on through the ministry. As employees of the ministry, you are not to worry about where the money will come from; Just work! As partners, ours is to bring the money. My goal now is to start giving a million shillings every month – as the money flows in, it will flow out." He encourages fellow partners of the ministry to be regular and cheerful in their giving. Above all, they should enroll into Charis Bible College. Thank you partners for your support. You are touching the nations and impacting lives.



Even though new businesses and ministries get launched every day, good leaders are hard to come by. If you want to be a better leader, you need to learn the four Cs of leadership: conductor, coach, culture creator, and having capacity.

Let's take a closer look at these principles. As a conductor, you chart the course for your organization or department and outline the path you expect to take together. Conductors are always in charge of two things: the people they lead and the work to be done. But people must never be sacrificed for the sake of work. Imagine an orchestra: help your people master their instruments, and then you can conduct them as they play.


The coach does double duty as both leader and mentor. The most important part of mentoring is listening, so you should never try to mentor someone you haven't first observed and listened to. By doing so, you'll learn important aspects of your team, like how they approach tasks and interpret plans. Understanding **how** a person thinks is just as important as understanding **what** he or she thinks. As a coach, it's also important to spend your time with teachable people, not just people you like.

You may have heard the saying "Culture trumps vision." And that's a true statement in the context of a good organizational culture with a safe, secure environment. But culture is like gravity.

In the same way that you expect gravity to work, a healthy culture teaches people what to expect, and you need to create that culture. A great way to accomplish this is to communicate directly, honestly, regularly, and transparently, and to empower your people to make decisions.

To grow your capacity, you need to be a lifelong learner. Learn something new every day that will help you improve yourself and advance in what God has called you to do. Good leaders must study how to make better decisions. The best decision makers base their decisions on both information (head) and gut feelings (heart). Most people use one method or the other, but you need to learn to do both.

Conducting, coaching, culture creation, and capacity: whether your goal is to be successful in business, ministry, or both, establishing good leadership skills is crucial to your success.
