

The Faith of God

All believers recognize the importance of faith. Faith is critical to our relationship with the Lord. The Bible says it's impossible to please God without faith (Heb. 11:6) and that all things are possible to those who believe (Mark 9:23).

So, the question isn't "Do we need faith?" The question is "Do we have faith—and is it enough?"

The answer is that you have the same quality and quantity of faith that Jesus had. It's not your faith in Him, but His faith at work in you. It came as part of your salvation.

Most Christians don't embrace this truth, and they're constantly trying to increase their faith. Jesus' disciples thought this same way. When they asked the Lord to increase their faith, Jesus answered them with a parable.

And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

Luke 17:6

This is a remarkable statement. Jesus is saying that faith is so powerful that even a tiny amount, like a grain of mustard seed, is enough to pluck up a tree and cast it into the sea. The disciples didn't need more faith; they just needed to use what they had. The just live by faith (Gal. 3:11). They don't vacation there.

We are born again by the faith of Jesus, not just by faith in Jesus. Before salvation, we were so destitute that we couldn't even believe the good news of what Jesus did for us without God giving us His faith. Ephesians 2:8 says, "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God."

It's true that salvation is a gift of God. We couldn't save ourselves. But it's also true that the faith it takes to receive salvation is a gift from God. Think about it. Human faith is based on our five senses—what we see, taste, hear, smell, and feel. Some say it takes faith to fly in a plane or even sit in a chair. But these are examples of human faith, which everyone has. The airline industry is carefully regulated and bears severe penalties if they don't follow safety protocols, so you have sensible reasons to trust a commercial flight. And before you sit in a chair, you look to see if it's solid. If a four-legged chair was leaning against a wall with only three legs, you wouldn't sit in it. That's sight-based faith.

When it comes to salvation, you're believing in things that can't be seen or felt. You're believing in a God you've never seen to forgive your intangible sins. You can't do that with just human faith. So where does that faith come from?

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:17

You can't become born again without the Lord imparting faith to you through His Word. He had to impart a supernatural faith to us so we could believe in things we can't see.

At the moment of salvation, every Christian is given the measure of faith, not a measure of faith. That's significant. There aren't different measures of faith. We're all given the same measure.

If I was serving soup in a cafeteria line and only had one measure, such as a ladle, then everyone would receive the same measure of soup. But if I used a ladle for some, and a tablespoon for others, and then a teaspoon for someone else, everyone would get different amounts. That's the concept that many Christians have.

They think the Lord gave a different amount of faith to each believer. They think that they just don't have as much faith as others—as if God accidently spilled some of their portion when He was dispensing their measure of faith.

Well, that is not what Romans 12:3 says. I'm aware that some modern versions of Romans 12:3 say "a measure" instead of "the measure," but that's not correct. We can verify this through other scriptures.

Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Galatians 2:16 (emphasis added)

Did you notice that this verse speaks twice about being justified by the faith of Jesus, not just faith in Jesus? Then Paul says it again:

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Galatians 2:20 (emphasis added)

Paul was living by the faith of Jesus. So how much faith did he have? He had the same amount of faith Jesus had! And since every believer has received the measure of faith (Rom. 12:3), we too have the same faith Paul had. It's the faith of Jesus.

Knowing that God gives everyone the same measure of faith at salvation is absolutely critical, but I've only scratched the surface of this subject. I encourage you to learn more about the spiritual laws of faith and how to activate them in your life. I go more in depth on this in my new teaching, The Faith of God, available as a CD or DVD series. I believe it will help you understand the magnitude of what a tiny amount of faith can accomplish. 

Recently, there was a partnership breakfast meeting to launch the **Discipleship Evangelism (DE)** program in the city of Mbarara. The results of the meeting were amazing. It was very evident that the men and women and indeed every living thing in Mbarara yearns for the true gospel, hence, they received the ministry warmly. It was an answered prayer for many who had no easy access to the capital city of Kampala to receive these life-changing resources, but were eager to receive teachings from Andrew Wommack.

Last weekend (7th Oct 2022), the ministry was able to start the first DE program with about 40 leaders in attendance at Adit Mall Mbarara.

Arthur first heard about Andrew Wommack in 2011. The teachings transformed his life to the extent that he was persecuted in his traditional church. However, he and his wife Esther continued to read Andrews books and listen to his teachings. At one point they wanted to join the bible college, but distance was a barrier.

Lo and behold, when they received a message that the ministry is coming to Mbarara, he and his wife were full of excitement. It was also mentioned that very soon Charis Bible College will be coming to Mbarara. They were elated and told the director Pastor Junaid that they would be the first people to register and become students! They believe God has called them to raise up ministers. Joining Charis Bible College will sharpen them and fulfill this call.

Arthur said they can't wait to be part of the next teachings of the DE. "We are so humbled to be part of Andrew Wommack Ministries. Thank you for taking interest in us. It is God that has put it in your heart to bring Andrew Wommack Ministries to Mbabara."

Queen Esther testified of how the ministry impacted her life and marriage. She shares how she now knows God as her friend and father who doesn't use evil to draw her attention to Him. Esther had challenges with her health for which the doctors couldn't help her. But she began to apply the principles of the word and standing on it as taught by Andrew. Miraculously, her health was restored and has since resurrected. God opened a door for her by providing a job. She's now working and teaches in an international school. She is grateful to God and the ministry that she has not stayed the same.

There is a desire inside all human beings to make a difference in the world. But how can you make a difference in the lives of others if you don't understand who you are and how God sees you? The good news is you are a child of God! And as a child of God, you have access to the grace of God to do many things you never thought possible.

So often, people fail to turn to the truth in the Word of God because they have a wrong perception of how God sees them. They believe they have to perform to receive God's love. But it's not about what you can do for God-it's about what God has already done for you through Jesus! It's not about what you deserve; it's about God's grace.

According to Ephesians 2:2–5, you are no longer under sin. Ephesians 2:4–7 says that even when you were stuck under sin, God and Jesus moved toward you so you could be delivered from sin into new life. So, when God looks at you, He doesn't see death and sin. He sees the life and grace that Jesus gave you. God wants to you to experience His mercy and kindness, and Ephesians 2:8–10 shows you how you can receive it: by choosing it.

The same faith you placed in God for your salvation can also be put into receiving God's grace. You just need to take a leap of faith and embrace it! When you do, you'll start seeing His supernatural power

working in and through you. The amazing grace of God is accessible to you because you chose Him, and you've been accepted in the beloved (Eph. 1:6). That truth will transform your life and allow you to make a difference in the lives of others.



Healings

- A woman was healed from cancer with the symptoms leaving her body within seven days of being prayed for at Charis **Zimbabwe**'s Healing School.
- Brenda in South Africa read Andrew's book on Romans and was delivered from a twentyyear drug addiction without withdrawals, weight gain, or medication.

Book Translation

Our AWM offices often oversee translations of Andrew's books. Each translated book can then reach another nation and culture with Andrew's message of grace and faith, taught with his simplicity and clarity direct from God's Word. Currently, forty-two of Andrew's titles have been translated into thirty-six languages, with more in progress.
