

Galatians: Speaking the Truth in Love

When was the last time someone you respected corrected you? Telling the truth, even if it means risking rejection, is a strong indication of someone's genuine concern. In the book of Galatians, we have a front-row seat to the Apostle Paul's loving but stern correction to the Galatian church.

Galatia is the same region where Paul had been stoned and left for dead and afterward preached the Gospel to those same people who harmed him. And the church that grew there was doing well until a group of Judaizers convinced the people that faith in Jesus was not enough. They told the Christians they needed to maintain Old Testament laws such as feast days, Sabbath days, and circumcision to be accepted by God. These were professing believers in Jesus as the Messiah, yet they said faith in Christ alone was insufficient for salvation

When the Apostle Paul found out what was going on, he was pretty upset. In fact, the book of Galatians contains some of the sharpest rebukes in all the Bible, yet Paul was willing to communicate the truth to these people out of love for them.

You need to tell people the truth. Sad to say, few Christians today are willing to speak the truth in love if it means offending someone or, worse, getting themselves in trouble. They would rather take the path of least resistance. Telling people the truth won't always affect them in a positive way. **But the truth is**

the only thing that will set people free, so you've got to tell people the truth.

Paul's apostleship was foundational to his message, so he opens this epistle by saying he was an apostle not by the will of man but by the calling of God Himself. He was getting ready to reprimand the Galatians for straying from the Gospel he had brought to them, and he wanted to firmly establish his authority to do so.

But notice how he starts off his chastisement with, "Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ" (Gal. 1:3). That's because the rebuke he was about to give wasn't because he didn't love these people; it was because he did love them.

One of my favorite scriptures I use all the time is Galatians 4:16 which says, "Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the truth?" When people set up rules and things you must do to be accepted by God, that's not the biblical Gospel.

Today, people will say you've got to go to church, pay your tithes, and live a holy life to get God to answer your prayers. They embrace the need for Jesus but say you also need to provide your own holiness. That's a perversion of the Gospel, and it's exactly what the Apostle Paul is preaching against.

Paul said you're either saved by grace without any

work on your part or you're saved by works without any grace on God's part (Rom. 11:6). He is saying salvation is either by Jesus alone or it's you alone not a combination of the two. The only thing we contribute to our salvation is our sin.

Scripture says Jesus died for the ungodly (Rom. 4:5). So unless you're willing to admit you're ungodly, you can't be saved. Any person that's maintaining their own goodness can't be saved.

It's hard for some people to understand, but did you know some people's goodness is the very thing that's keeping them from relationship with God? Am I saying you shouldn't live a righteous life or do what's good? No, that's not what I'm saying. What I am saying is that if your trust is in yourself and in your goodness instead of trusting in Jesus, it will send you to hell.

Grace is so infinitely superior to your having to earn God's favor and live up to all these things. You'd have to be crazy to accept legalism rather than the grace of God. God's grace makes everything available to you based on what Jesus did. It's not what you do for Jesus—it's what Jesus did for you.

It's faith that gives us access to God, not our own attempts at holiness and certainly not our meager performance. We should live holy so we don't give an inroad to Satan. We should live holy because God has changed us and we're a brand-new person. But we do not have to live holy to deserve the things of **God.** And if you think you do, that could be the very thing that's stopping the power of God from flowing in your life.


The truth is you aren't worthy. But the good news is you don't have to be worthy. All you must do is put faith in a savior who obtained all these things for you by His holiness. And He offers it to you as a free gift. That's the pure Gospel. Praise the Lord!



"We set off for Mbarara Healing Conference on Wednesday 26th October 2022 with a small team of staff. Amazingly they managed to cover the full set-up, worship, media, and ministering at the conference.

The setting off was quite event-filled with unprecedented delays and this focussed us on the fact that this trip was significant. A trip which was set for set off at 9.00am, we ended up leaving past half midday after overcoming a series of hurdles! Even when we set off, one of the teams made a long detour unintentionally, however it worked out for our good because we escaped and left behind all the traffic jam on the main road!

Healing is Here Conference was held on Thursday 27th October from 5.00pm to 7.00pm.

We had a very heavy rain with a blizzard which came in prior to the conference start time, and this was coupled with the fact that the conference was being held on a Thursday which is a workday. So, at the end of a workday and with a heavy rain aftermath, we totally trusted God for the numbers that were to show up.

God cares for everyONE! He would leave the Ninety-Nine sheep to go after the one! (Matt 18:12-13). And this was the attitude with which the whole team wholesomely dived into the event. To our amazement, we got over thirty Pastors attending the conference. And these were pastors alone, in addition to the general public. In sum-total we had a little over 100 persons attending.

We had a teaching from Pastor Junaid about blind Bartimaeus who threw off his cloak of begging and blindness and went away a new person and freed from the impediment of blindness and that old cloak!

Response from the audience after the teaching on healing?

People were called for ministry of healing and almost three quarters of the public gathered around the pulpit.

A lady who had come in with visual issues left with restored eyesight after being ministered to by Pr. Kelly.

A lady who had demonic manifestation and was writhing on the floor, after a long time of many ministers laying hands on her and praying over her and declaring the love of God over her, she finally responded to Pr. Kelly's call out to her to resist this evil oppression and sit up and then she would get something to eat! She responded and she sat up, she was offered Pizza and she ate it and then they walked away with the family with her in very sane and proper condition.

On engaging pastors that attended the conference and inquiring about their experience from the Healing Conference, this is what they had to say:

Pastor 1: She saw the glory of God. Many people got healed and people are still giving testimony for financial release and spiritual release. Her next question is when are we going back to Mbarara for the Healing Conference?

Pastor 2: She was feeling so much pain and was not able to walk for long distances by the time she came for the conference. She got healed that day when she was instructed to speak to that pain and command it to leave! And since then she has no pain at all. And she is so excited, she is mobilizing other friends to come for the next Healing Conference Mbarara which is scheduled for 17th November 2022.

Response when there was an inquiry about those who would like to join the Bible College:

The response when people were asked who wanted to attend the bible college, almost the entire congregation put their hands up.

The Healing Conference is Here Mbarara of October 2022 was a great experience for those who attended and we trust the upcoming one of November 2022 shall have more attendance after the ones who attended tell the story.
