TEN GODLY LEADERSHIP ESSENTIALS

Leadership is a popular topic that I've often been asked to teach on, but I've been reluctant to do so. That may sound strange coming from someone who is seen as a leader, but let me explain. In my eyes, being a godly leader is all about following the Lord and cultivating a strong relationship with Him. So even though I am a leader, I've never pursued leadership roles or mentors in that area. Until two years ago, I had never even attended a leadership conference.

Despite that, I now lead a global team of over 1,100 employees and oversee more than fifty Charis Bible College campuses as well as worldwide broadcasts in multiple languages. My books have been translated into nearly forty languages and distributed worldwide. So I have found myself in a leadership position without actively pursuing it. As I sought the Lord about why that is, He showed me that because my pursuit has been focused on Him, He has guided me and shown me what steps to take. **When you choose to follow the Lord, you automatically become a good leader.**

You know, I've had multiple people come and help me in the ministry, and there was one person who did a lot of good things, but he was like a steamroller and hurt a lot of people in the process. That is not godly leadership, so I had to let him go. There are a lot of people who learn their leadership principles from the world, but I tell you, Jesus said, "*he that is greatest among you shall be your servant*" (Matt. 23:11)—and He demonstrated this by the way He serves us and gave His life for us.

I have made a list of what I consider to be the top ten essentials of godly leadership and arranged them in a particular order because I believe the sequence

is significant. By going through these essentials step by step, you'll gain a more comprehensive understanding of what it means to be a godly leader.

Relationship with the Lord

The number one essential quality is relationship with the Lord. I believe that close relationship with God produces godly leadership. We should only expect people to follow us as we follow Jesus Christ. Paul said in 1 Corinthians 11:1, "*Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.*" He was basically saying the same thing I'm trying to say, which is that **the best leaders are also good followers.** And if you're not a good follower—if you don't have a close relationship with God, and you're not being led by God—you'll be a bad leader or lead people in the wrong direction.

So, for me, it all comes down to this one thing: if you have a good relationship with the Lord and listen to Him, He will tell you everything you need to do. He will tell you where you need to go, when you need to turn, who you need to appoint, and everything else. So, basically, everything comes from your relationship with the Lord. That's the first step.

Humility

The second attribute that's essential to godly leadership is humility, which also comes out of intimacy with the Lord. Humbling yourself in true relationship with God means you aren't running your life. It means you've surrendered your life to the Lord as a living sacrifice (Rom. 12:1).

I was born again at eight years old and genuinely saved, but I became like a religious Pharisee. My church taught that the degree to which God moved in your life was directly related to how well you lived. So I lived a strict life. But on March 23, 1968, I had a life-changing encounter with God. And the moment when He showed me His holiness and my comparative unworthiness, all the wind was knocked out of my sails. That experience with the Lord produced genuine humility in me.

Certainly, none of us have obtained unto perfection in this, but God took my attention off of myself very quickly. In Isaiah 42:8, God said about the Son, *'I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another.'* God is not going to give His glory to anybody but Jesus. **So, if you are in ministry to magnify yourself, you are actually going to wind up with God fighting against you, and it won't work.**

But when you put God and other people ahead of yourself, you won't get stressed out or burned out. If you are really spending time in the presence of the Lord, I guarantee it'll stop you from operating in pride, which is Satan's biggest inroad into your life. I know that's a big statement, but I honestly believe that depression, worry, care, fear—they're all just a manifestation of you taking control and doing things on your own instead of casting your care over on the Lord (1 Pet. 5:7).

Character and Integrity

The third essential quality of godly leadership is made up of character and integrity. If you have truly put God first in your life, it will produce character and integrity in you. If I were presented with an opportunity to lie, cheat, steal, or do anything else that goes against God, I would never think, *Well, Lord, am I going to do this?* There's no question

because I already decided decades ago that I'm not going in that direction. I see it as a simple way to eliminate all the worst-case scenarios in all parts of my life, including in my role as a leader.

When you put God first in your life, there won't be any struggle over things like this—because He's the one running your life. **That automatically produces character and integrity.** You don't have to seek these out; they're just byproducts of relationship with God. Satan can't tempt you with the things of this world because you *don't care*. That's the way I live my life. I just haven't pursued anything except God.

If the Lord is number one in your life and you aren't exalting yourself, I guarantee that God will speak to you and guide you to where you need to go. And God's plans are big. God wants to reach people. God's the one that put the call on each person's life. He has a purpose for your life, and He will make your life better than you could ever dream of on your own. But it all comes out of relationship with the Lord. Proverbs 3:5 says to *"trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding."* The best thing you can do is not run your own life but be a living sacrifice instead.

I won't be able to cover all ten essentials of godly leadership in this article, but in my full teaching, I go into greater depth about these three and the other seven points. I really believe it will strengthen your relationship with the Lord and give you insight into what true godly leadership is all about. "Daddy, I need mercy."

These were the words uttered by my sons when I caught them stealing rocks from the first church I pastored. Despite being warned about the consequences, they attempted it again. When their day of reckoning arrived, they pleaded through tears, "Daddy, we need mercy. That's when you don't get what you deserve." Perhaps, like my sons, you recognize God's mercy—but what do you truly understand about grace?

Let's explore four essential facets of grace that you need to know:

#1 Grace gives you what you don't deserve.

The Greek word for grace is also translated as "divine favor" (*HELPS Word-studies*). This favor is God's power allowing you to be what He has called you to be—a joint heir, a new creation, righteous, a child of God, and more—and to do what He has called you to do, which is to declare and perform the works of God!

#2 The reign of grace breaks sin's tyranny.

Romans 6:14 assures us that sin does not have dominion over us—because we're no longer under the law but under grace instead. The Apostle Paul asserts that falling from grace occurs when you revert to living under the law (Gal. 5:4). You don't fall from grace when you sin; you fall when you trust in the law to fight sin. Once you get a revelation of God's grace, you'll overcome sin!

#3 Grace is personified by Jesus.

Paul reminds us in 1 Corinthians 15 that he became an apostle of grace after his encounter with Jesus on the road to Damascus. Paul wasn't taught grace; he met grace—Jesus! He got a revelation of grace, and it knocked him off his donkey! If you want to understand grace, you don't just need doctrine; you need Jesus!

What You Didn't Know About the Power of God's Grace in Your Life

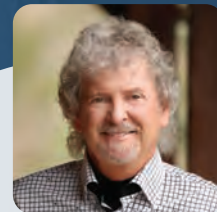
#4 Grace is required to operate in God's vision for your life!

You are called to minister the manifold grace of God (1 Pet. 4:10). The Greek word translated as "manifold" in this verse also means "diverse" (*Strong's Exhaustive Concordance*). You can study the various grace gifts outlined in 1

Corinthians 12, remembering that your gift is unique to you! When you acknowledge that God has freely given you gifts, you won't compare yourself to others. Humble acceptance of this gift of grace, unmerited favor, is key to fulfilling God's vision for your life.

Hopefully, you see the importance of God's grace in your life. Be thankful for mercy, but remember, God took it a step further and gave you access to His power—His grace—to fulfill your calling!

Highly Favored

When I was in Russia and ministering to the men's and women's drug rehab centers, the devil started lying to me and saying, "You're not the one. You're not qualified, and you don't know enough—God could use someone better."

Then the Lord began to minister to me on five things, and they really came alive as I hid the Word of God in my heart. I shared these five revelations everywhere I ministered in Russia because they are so crucial for us to grasp in our walk with the Lord.

I even learned how to say this one really long sentence in Russian so I could speak these five things over the people I ministered to in their own language:

“Ты призван, ты благословен, ты помазан и любимчик Господа.” (Pronunciation: Ty prizvan, ty blagosloven, ty pomazan i lyubimchik Gospoda.)

I was basically saying, "You're called. You're blessed. You're anointed. You're highly favored of the Lord, and you're deeply loved."

When God looks at you, He sees you as called. He sees you as blessed. He sees you as anointed. He sees you highly favored of the Lord, and He sees that you are deeply loved.

Cancerous Tumor Vanishes by Faith!



You have all you need to live a victorious life in Christ Jesus—including healing! It isn't something you earn; it is received by grace through faith. Mike and Caroline Hoesch, once trapped in legalism, discovered this truth when Mike's life was threatened by cancer.

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:8–9

In 2000, Mike noticed a pimple on his chest. He thought nothing of it until it grew larger and became inflamed and irritated. Mike believed God was his healer, so he prayed, but the bump didn't go away.

After going to a dermatologist, Mike learned that he had malignant neoplasm—a cancerous tumor that spreads throughout the body. The doctor then scheduled surgery to remove it. Following the appointment, Mike told his wife about it and went to his pastor for guidance. The pastor didn't think God used procedures like that to heal people. In their legalistic church, going to the doctor to get a tumor removed was considered sin. And according to their beliefs, if someone were sinning, they shouldn't expect God to heal them. Mike called the office and canceled his tumor removal surgery. The doctor from his earlier appointment called back after learning about the cancellation and warned Mike that he could die. This caused a fear in Mike that only God's love could cast out.

In 2002, Mike got very sick with the flu, and things proceeded to get worse. The tumor produced a terrible smell and grew heavier, so Caroline

covered it with an herb tincture, wrapped it in paper towels, and made a sling out of bras to hold it up.

It eventually got to the point where Caroline didn't even want to leave him home alone because she feared she'd come home and find him dead. Realizing his body was dying, Mike dove into the Word for encouragement.

Then one day, a family friend gave Mike and Caroline a copy of Andrew's teaching *You've Already Got It*, which would forever change their lives. The message taught them that **God hadn't been withholding anything from them** (Is. 53:5 and 1 Pet. 2:24). It also confirmed the scriptures Mike had already been studying for months on his own. After drawing their "line in the sand" by deciding to believe the Word, Caroline noticed the mass was starting to shrink in size. Mike expected nothing less because he just *knew* Jesus had healed him. "Although, I still had to deal with the tumor twice a day," he says, "I honestly forgot that it was there because God healed me. It *had* to get smaller. Nothing else could happen."

In seven months, the tumor had completely vanished! Now cancer-free, he ministers full-time, passionately sharing the redemptive work of Jesus! Thank you, partners! Your support brought the life-changing message of the Gospel to Mike, and he is alive today because of your generous support.

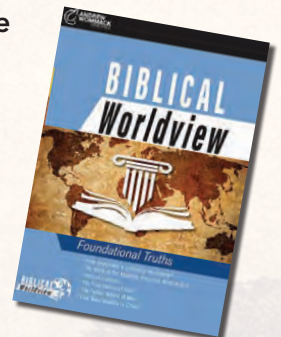

CHRONIC NUMBNESS SILENCED BY THE WORD OF GOD

In 2012, Robert Khamson Mwambu was making paper bags for a living when he developed numbness in his right thumb which he first ignored, but it kept increasing over the years. While working in South Sudan in 2019 and managing his situation, the numbness greatly intensified and spread to his legs threatening his ability to walk, drive and care for himself! With a very heavy heart, he left his job and returned to Uganda for medical treatment.

The diagnosis was a cancerous tumor at the tip of his Spinal code and emergency surgery was recommended by the doctor at a cost of 21,000,000. While he and his family processed the shock and tried to fundraise the funds, the COVID Pandemic hit the world in 2020 and he stayed home until May 2022 when he was finally operated on. The tumor was removed then he underwent radiotherapy until November 2022. By this time, he had lost so much weight and some friends had written him off as dead, while others insisted that it was witchcraft.

In 2023, Robert had gone through medical treatment, but the numbness persisted. Items still fell out of his right hand because he was unable to grip things and he also used his left hand to eat. He processed the heart-breaking realization that medicine would not offer complete restoration which was intensely frustrating, and he became suicidal.

In May 2023, he started listening to Andrew Wommack teachings on Impact Radio which he found very encouraging. He decided to visit the offices and at the bookstore, a prayer minister agreed with him in prayer, invited him to the Healing School Service and to enroll for the Discipleship Evangelism classes. His enrollment form was filled out for him because he was unable to hold a pen and write due to the numbness!

The classes kicked off and it was during the lessons titled "The Power of a Spirit filled life" that a scripture came alive to him.

Acts 10:38 *how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with Power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.*

He realized that the devil had oppressed him for a long time, and it was time up! He commanded numbness to leave his body in the name of Jesus, and the next day, he decided to test his faith and do some things that he had been unable to do.

He took out all his dirty laundry and hand washed which he had not been able to do in over 10 years. His siblings who had been his support system were amazed as he made himself a glass of juice as well – something he had longed to be able to do again.

After 10 years, he is healed and excited about returning for more classes.
