
# GOSPELTRUTH









I've met many Christians who want to see more of God in their lives. What they often don't realize is that their experience of His power and presence is tied to their imagination. Now, when I say "imagination," most Christians think I'm talking about fantasy or mind over matter. I'm not talking about either one. Did you know that Scripture has a lot to say about the imagination? When it's used in a positive sense, Scripture calls it hope!

For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?

Romans 8:24

The part of you that hopes is a result of the part of you that imagines. How? Because when you hope, you're creating a mental picture of what you'd like to see happen. There are many scriptures on this topic. Let's start with a verse in Hebrews.

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:1

You could say it this way: Faith is the substance of your positive imagination, the evidence of things not seen. According to this verse, faith brings into reality the things that you positively imagine. It's like your spiritual womb. Your imagination will conceive what God's Word says, and then faith brings to birth the things that you've conceived.

Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

Isaiah 26:3

The Hebrew word for mind in this verse is "yetser" which means conception, which is also translated as imagination. I don't know if that helps you, but it blesses me! This is so important, because there are a lot of people who look at hope as a non-issue. As a

matter of fact, many faith people have downplayed the role of hope. It says in 1 Corinthians 13:13,

And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.

People in the faith crowd, of course, will emphasize faith. And they understand the importance of love and how it's the greatest of all. But did you know that hope should be right up there as one of the greatest forces, with faith and love?

When I've heard people use the word hope when talking about receiving from God, I've heard others criticize them, saying, "You don't need to hope; you need to believe!" They don't realize that without hope—without a positive imagination—you can't believe! If there's nothing hoped for, faith doesn't have anything to give substance to.

It's not just believe and receive. You have to conceive the Word, then you believe what it says, and then you receive what it promises. You might ask, "How do you conceive the Word of God?" Proverbs 23:7 says, "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he."

What you think or meditate on is how you conceive things, whether good or bad. If you meditate on your circumstances, that's what you'll conceive. It'll be a self-fulfilling prophecy! But if you meditate on what God's Word has to say, you'll conceive





what God's Word says. It'll change everything about you—how you see yourself, your circumstances, everything. That's powerful! I hope you are getting this.

> Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he **meditate** day and night Psalm 1:1–2 (emphasis added)

> Why do the heathen rage, and the people **imagine** a vain thing? Psalm 2:1 (emphasis added)

The word meditate in Psalm 1:2 is the same word that's translated as imagine in Psalm 2:1. Your heart is like soil that'll grow whatever thoughts are sown into it (Mark 4:26–28). What goes into your heart is what you imagine happening. Your imagination will go in the direction of your dominant thoughts. That's why you have to make sure that you guard your heart (Prov. 4:23).

You know, if don't have a specific place to go, well then any old road will do. You could just head in any direction because it wouldn't matter. But if you want to go in a specific destination—say from Texas to New York—you have to picture in your mind where New York City is and visualize the direction that you'll be going. Whether you look at a map or use a GPS, you have to move in a certain direction. You have to have the end goal in sight. And if you're traveling a long distance, and it's going to take you more than one day to get to a certain place, you know what? You have to have some idea that you're going to spend the night somewhere along the way. You have to think about these things. All of that is your imagination.

Some of the things I'm saying are hard to put into words because I'm talking about things you can't see. But this is the way I live! My ministry and my relationship with God would not be where they are today without putting these things into practice. There are a lot of goals that I've set that I believe are from the Lord. The only way that I know I'll get there is if I imagine the things God has put on my heart and meditate on them. When I do, they'll paint a picture on the inside of me that I'll be able to see manifest through faith. They are going to come to pass.

Sometimes it may not look like it, but you watch: whether it's finances or healing or whatever, I am going to have all that I need to accomplish everything that God has told me to accomplish. Whatever I do shall prosper!



Andrew Wommack's Gospel Truth program is now airing in ten different languages with Spanish being the tenth one, reaching an even broader audience through voice actor translations. Language is no longer a barrier for Spanish-speaking viewers, making the truth shine brighter than ever before!

Spanish is the second-most spoken language in the world, so the introduction of the new Spanish broadcast is a major milestone for Andrew Wommack Ministries. The establishment of our exciting new Spanish ministry department has been in the works for over five years, so it is a blessing to see this amazing vision unfold into reality!



In addition to Andrew's new Gospel Truth en Español program that initially aired April 2022, the Spanish ministry department and others have worked together to open a phone center in Mexico; broadcast Andrew's show in Spanish on Enlace, an international Christian TV network; duplicate the English AWM website into Spanish; create Spanish social media accounts like Facebook and YouTube, and more!



Our Spanish ministry department and other teams have been working to reproduce all of our English materials for our Spanish-speaking audience. We have numerous teams working tirelessly to reach our newest audience with the Good News. Our efforts are not only impacting the Spanish-speaking audience in America but also in nearly sixty countries around the world.



The results have been remarkable from the start. Our Mexico phone center received around two thousand phone calls during its early stages. After Andrew's show began airing in Spanish, Charis Mexico experienced a surge in public interest. Additionally, our new social media platforms reached almost 150,000 viewers in just a few months.

The intense behind-the-scenes planning for this massive project all started with our former television producer, Michael Mohr. He caught a glimpse of the future and began working with the AWM Mexico office to translate *The Gospel Truth* into Español. Enrique de la Vega, the current bilingual Spanish ministry specialist, is now carrying the torch to expand the vision beyond its initial conception.

Due to Enrique's personal experiences with the suffocating weight of legalism often felt in many Hispanic churches, he understands the importance of reaching the Hispanic community. He was once trapped in religious bondage until he learned about God's love through Andrew's Gospel Truth program. His newfound freedom in God's grace ignited a fire in Enrique's heart. Now he is passionate about seeing other Spanish-speakers hear the same



message that changed his life.

The world may be growing darker, but it's in the midst of the darkness that light shines the brightest. In this month's edition of "Good Reports," we're excited to inspire and encourage you with some more good news!



### Oklahoma Governor Signs the "Women's Bill of Rights"

The day Oklahoma Republican Governor Kevin Stitt signed an executive order that's being referred

to as the "Women's Bill of Rights," he said, "Today we're taking a stand against this out-of-control gender ideology that is eroding the very foundation of our society. We are going to be safeguarding the very essence of what it means to be a woman. Oklahomans are fed up with attempts to confuse the word woman and turn it into some kind of ambiguous definition that harms real women."

This Oklahoma policy recognizes that there are only two genders and clearly defines the words female, male, man, boy, woman, girl, father, and mother. The executive order defines a female as a "person whose biological reproductive system is designed to produce ova" and a male as a "person whose biological reproductive system is designed to fertilize the ova of a female."

Schools and state agencies must comply with those definitions when collecting data and provide restrooms and locker rooms dedicated for boys and girls, respectively. Stitt signed this executive order surrounded by female doctors, athletes, and business leaders, including Riley Gaines, a former University of Kentucky swimmer who took her case for fairness in women's sports

all the way to the U.S. Senate.



Praise God for Governor Stitt, who has decided to take a stand for what's biblical and right!

"I have three daughters," Stitt said. "My wife and I have been married for twenty-five years. I did this for them, for Riley Gaines, and for all the young girls in the state of Oklahoma." Stitt stated that requiring women to compete against biological men is insane enough. But forcing women to undress in locker rooms with biological men during competitions is "absolutely wrong."

### More Bills Protecting Rights in Oklahoma

- In May 2023, Governor Stitt signed a bill into law making it a crime for healthcare workers to conduct irreversible gender transition surgeries and hormone therapies for children under the age of eighteen.
- The governor has also previously signed measures prohibiting biological boys and men from playing on female sports teams and requiring a public school student to only use the bathroom of the sex listed on their birth certificate.
- In April 2022, Stitt signed a bill forbidding the use of nonbinary gender markers on state birth certificates. Senator Micheal Bergstrom, the Senate sponsor of this bill, made the statement, "We must stand up and put a stop to this nonsense regarding biological sex. It's not a complicated issue—biologically, you're either a male or female. There should be no other option to choose from on a birth certificate."

That's an incredible thought—the thoughts that God thinks toward you and me far outnumber the sands of the sea. God has had a lot of time to think about you and to place you in the place that you're in. And God's plans for you are better than any plan you could ever develop for yourself.

Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Psalm 37:5

The word "commit" comes from the Hebrew word galal, and it means "to roll" (Strong's Concordance).

Imagine taking a blank piece of paper and crumpling it into a ball. This ball symbolizes your life and the plans you have made. Now, picture another piece of paper being crumpled around the first one. This represents God's will and His plans for your life. This concept of surrounding one crumpled paper with another is exactly what the Hebrew word *galal* means—to completely roll up into another.

committed with all your heart to the Lord and being able to say, "Lord, it's not about me; it's about You. It's about what You want for me. It's about the desires You have for my life—I'm laying this down."

Psalm 37:5 is about truly being

What you're doing is you're taking your life, this piece of paper (the inner ball), and you're rolling it up into another life, God's life (the outer piece of paper wrapped over it). It's like you're saying, "I may have a crumpled life, but I'm giving it to You, and now I'm covered by You."


Now the two, which were two pieces of paper, have become one. They're inseparable. One's encompassed inside the other. So now, wherever you take this outer piece of paper, the inner piece of paper goes too.

We're now rolled up in Christ Jesus, and we're committed to Him. Wherever God goes, we go. Whatever He thinks, we think. Whatever He does, we do.

What an amazing concept, being committed! We're making that commitment and we're not backing out. I'm committed to my wife. I have a covenant with her. She'll never get rid of me. Why? Because I'm committed to her. And that's the same thing we're doing in our relationship with the Lord. It's no longer about you or me, but the God who lives in us (1 Cor. 6:17 and Gal. 2:20).

Psalm 18:30

What's the best way to understand God's true nature? It's through His Word—the Bible! God's heart and intentions are revealed all throughout Scripture, and reading it will help you gain a clearer understanding of who God really is. It's great to pray and talk to God, but it's essential that you also engage with His Word.

Throughout history, religious institutions have often painted a distorted picture of God that leads many people astray. Sadly, those misrepresentations have created a lot of confusion about God's true nature. To break free from religious misconceptions, you need to seek the truth in God's Word for yourself. The Bible itself declares that God's Word is truth, and knowing it frees us from deception.

And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

John 8:32

One common misunderstanding propagated by some religious teachings concerns the sovereignty of God. God's authority and supremacy are absolute. However, it is crucial to recognize that God granted people free will and control over certain aspects of life. This is evident from the Scriptures, such as when God gave mankind dominion over the earth (Gen. 1:26).

Tragedies and difficult circumstances are not necessarily the result of God's will, as many have been led to believe. The Bible tells us we have an adversary (the devil) roaming around like a lion, seeking whom he may devour (1 Pet. 5:8). Having a correct understanding of God as the loving and compassionate Father that He is allows us to trust Him in challenging times rather than blaming Him for our hardships.

For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee.

Psalm 86:5

I hope you can see how vital it is to avoid creating your own version of who God is based on personal preferences or what religion has taught you. Instead, by reading the Bible, you can discover the true nature of God and develop a genuine relationship with Him that's based on truth, just as you would any other close friend. Because He's the greatest friend you'll ever have.








## From New Age TO GOD'S GRACE

The first book he read was Spirit, Soul & Body. It was simple, plain, and very empowering. From then on, Abraham's perspective changed about his identity and how God sees him.

Abraham says Andrew was a different kind of teacher, constantly pointing people to God and not to himself! Andrew emphasizes in one of his books that The Word is the supreme authority! This attitude in Andrew caused a great attraction and admiration in Abraham to Andrew's character of soberness, and he grew in trust towards his ministering.

Initially Abraham was reluctant to join the Bible College since he was accessing thousands of materials on the website! He was unaware that the Bible College had many other instructors!

Abraham also had other heart questions which he sought answers for! For example, he would see people around him falling under the anointing and yet he would remain seated in the midst of that multitude and feel absolutely nothing! What was the reason? These things challenged his faith! People professed extravagant faith! He felt there was still a knowledge gap!

At about this time, Abraham's co-worker joined Charis Bible College. Within the smallest space of time, he saw amazing visible transformation in her! Then he also noticed a confidence and maturity in fellow church members who had joined the college! He knew it was time for him to join.

When he eventually joined the Bible college in 2021, he got the answers to his questions! There was a maturity exhibited by students seated under The Word as they received their answers from knowledge and understanding of The Word!

As he encountered more instructors in the Bible College, he recognized the similar traits of quality and virtue in the instructors. They were incredibly open, honest, elderly teachers, each one speaking from their life experiences and heart relationship with God through The Word.

The question of Grace which had posed controversy with a lot of questions in the religious circle was so simply addressed in various classes. In one of them he gets to understand Grace at the Cross, and Grace at the resurrection! Grace at the Cross paid our price in full and Grace at the resurrection empowers us in the salvation journey in purpose! (Ephes 2:10).

Come to Charis Bible College and let the manifold Grace of God direct you into your purpose and calling. (1 Peter 4:10)
