# TWENTY REVELATIONS THAT WILL CHANGE YOUR LIFE; Beyond 1---Beyond Intellectual Knowledge

Have you ever experienced a miraculous encounter that ignited a fire within you? For me, it was the moment when the Lord touched my life fifty-five years ago. As I celebrate this milestone, I've been reflecting on the miraculous journey that brought me here. It wasn't just that initial encounter; it was the revelation knowledge that followed, transforming my life and guiding my steps.

My journey began with a life-changing encounter with the Lord on March 23, 1968, but I soon realized that living solely on past experiences wasn't enough. Have you ever had a glimpse of who God was and what He wanted to do in your life but had no clue about how to get from where you were to where God wanted you to be? That's where I was. Frustration began to set in as I lacked direction and clarity on how to progress further in my relationship with the Lord.

The turning point for me was when God began to reveal himself to me through His Word. It wasn't just intellectual knowledge but a real and intimate experience of God revealing His truth to me. I call this revelation knowledge, and it not only shaped me but also my ministry. I never would've made the impact that I have if it hadn't been for the Word of God and revelation knowledge.

The Apostle Paul demonstrated a powerful principle in 1 Corinthians 2:1-3, where he said Paul's ministry was not built on eloquence or charisma but on knowing Christ crucified. When you humble yourself, then God extends more grace to you, and He exalts you.

Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time.

1 Peter 5:6

Relationship with God is heart-to-heart—it goes beyond mere mental understanding. With the heart man believes (Rom. 10:10), and this belief shapes our actions and transforms our circumstances.

During my time in Vietnam, I led a Bible study with a group of guys. One day a skeptic joined us and stumped me with questions I couldn't answer. He ridiculed me and left, taking my whole group with him. So when he returned twenty minutes later and said he wanted what I had, I was shocked.

I learned from that experience that faith is more than debates—it's a real relationship rooted in personal encounters with God. You can't tell me there isn't a God, because I know Him. He lives on the inside of me. This is what drew this guy, and because of it, I was able to pray with him, lead him to the Lord, and he got born again!

There are things that come only by revelation. It's not just a matter of using your mind to figure everything out. I'm not saying that the mind isn't involved, but you've got to have it be inspired by the Holy Spirit.

The problem with the wisdom of this world is that it's limited to the physical realm. God's wisdom transcends intellect and enables us to believe in an unseen God who transforms our lives.





You know, a person can have multiple degrees, but it doesn't guarantee their success. The Apostle Paul was highly educated, yet he considered all his achievements totally worthless compared to knowing Christ through faith. He didn't discard his intellect but rather used it to analyze and interpret everything through revelation knowledge.

But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ. Yea doubtless. and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ.

Philippians 3:7–8

Paul received a revelation that even surpassed the intimate experiences of the twelve disciples. His understanding of the New Covenant and God's grace exceeded that of Peter's—who had physically walked the earth for three and a half years with Jesus. There is just nothing that compares to having God reveal His wisdom and truth to you at a heart level.

For example, did you know that when you're in need and don't have enough money, natural instinct will tell you to save and hold onto what you have? But because there is a God who says that when you give, it will be given back to you, giving away a portion of what you have will actually bring you closer to your goal.

When you trust in God and follow His guidance, even when you're lacking, you actually increase rather than decrease. It may not make sense to your natural mind, but in the kingdom of God, the way up is down. By giving instead of hoarding, you open yourself up to receiving more. These are truths that need to be understood through personal revelation.

The point I'm making is that revelation knowledge is far superior to just intellectual knowledge—it's a journey into the unseen realm of God's promises! It defies the limitations of the human mind and pleases God when we trust Him beyond reason. I am not saying Christianity is mindless. But a relationship with God goes beyond explanations; it's about experiencing His presence.

But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

1 Corinthians 2:10

The Word of God is alive and powerful. It inspires and transforms us as we read it with an open heart, allowing the Holy Spirit to reveal truth to us.

As I celebrate fifty-five years of ministry, I encourage you to seek more than just experiences. As you read God's Word, I pray you'll allow Him to light up your heart with the things He wants to help you understand. If you'll let the Lord shape your life through revelation knowledge, He'll lead you to heights you never thought possible.

THE TIMES: Our Role in Shaping Our Nation's Future

Brothers and sisters, I encourage you to return to your first love and to hold fast to the truth. I pray this quote from Reverend Charles Finney (*The Independent of New York*, 1873) challenges us to fully embrace our role in shaping the moral fabric of our nation:

Of the sons of Issachar who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do, their chiefs were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their command.

1 Chronicles 12:32, NKJV, emphasis added

The sons of Issachar were the smallest group of warriors that King David picked, yet they had a profound understanding of the times they lived in and what actions Israel needed to take.

We need to be asking God for understanding of the times we find ourselves in, recognizing we're not here by accident but have been placed in this specific season and location for a purpose. **God has a unique word and plan specifically for** *you*! He is raising up an army of believers who know how to fight the right fight, the right way.

As followers of Jesus, we are called by God to be the conscience of a nation!

We bear a solemn and holy responsibility to our generation. We must speak the truth in love, explain the signs of the times, and effectively communicate what needs to be done. Though a great fight of affliction awaits us, we must maintain our integrity and remain loyal to Jesus, even in the face of death.

Brethren, our preaching will bear its legitimate fruits. If immorality prevails in the land, the fault is ours in a great degree. If there is a decay of conscience, the pulpit is responsible for it. . . . Let us not ignore this fact, my dear brethren; but let us lay it to heart, and be thoroughly awake to our responsibility in respect to the morals of this nation.

The scripture about the sons of Issachar is an important reminder to understand the times and know what actions we ought to take. Let's embrace this responsibility and bring salvation, deliverance, and hope to those in need.

## Abortion Business Shuts Down for Good in Indiana!

Big news! A groundbreaking victory has been achieved in Indiana as an abortion business, Whole Woman's Health Alliance (WWHA), permanently shut down its South Bend location. According to a survey by Operation Rescue, the facility had stopped performing surgical abortions and was only administering chemical abortions. Notably, the Supreme Court of the United States (SCOTUS) recently upheld an Indiana law mandating the dignified burial or cremation of aborted babies. Interestingly, Amy Miller, the founder of WWHA, also operated a branch in Texas which closed after the overturning of Roe v. Wade. We praise God for this incredible victory!

## Transformed by Truth: Charis Student Healed from Generalized Anxiety Disorder

Donnie's life changed when his friend, who also happened to be a Charis student, introduced him to the transformative free course A Sure Foundation. ## The UK Has Limited the Prescription of Puberty-Suppressing Hormones for Children!

The British National Health Service has determined that "there is not enough evidence to support their [puberty-suppression drugs] safety or clinical effectiveness as a routinely available treatment" (NHS England, "Consultation report for the interim service specification for specialist gender incongruence services for children and young people," 2023). Although there will be some exceptions with those approved for clinical trials, this is still a major win! Castration drugs have been linked to sexual dysfunction, infertility, cancer, cardiac events, vocal cord problems, bone density issues, and transition regret. There is no evidence to support the idea that permanently altering a child's body would remedy their mental struggles. Jesus Christ and the Word of God are the only real solution. We are one step closer to protecting children in the UK. Praise God!

Influenced by the world, we've accepted far less than what God has provided. As long as you can live with less than God's best, you will. That is a powerful truth.

To experience all that God has for you, you must get sick and tired of being sick and tired. A holy dissatisfaction with mediocrity is necessary. It doesn't happen accidentally or automatically. You have to pursue it. If you don't, you won't get it.

Our fallen world naturally goes from good to bad. Things don't improve without effort. We must seek, knock, and ask to receive. We must raise our sights and aim higher. Most people are shooting at nothing and hitting it every time.

Jeremiah 29:11 reveals God's thoughts of peace and hope for us, even in devastating times. By calling upon Him, praying, and seeking Him with all our hearts, we can find Him. We must refuse to settle for anything less than God's best.

Many Christians lack this attitude. Expectations within the church have been lowered. Fear of disappointment leads ministers to teach people to settle for less. We have all been influenced by an ungodly culture, but we must start moving in the direction of God's best. There is more for all of us to experience.

We will stand before God one day and realize what we could have had on earth. The same power that raised Christ from the dead was always within us. We didn't have to be sick, broke, depressed, or discouraged. Love, joy, peace, and other virtues were always inside us.

Should I take this job? Should I buy this house? Should I marry this person? My wife and I pastored for twenty-seven years, and I can't tell you how many times we were asked these types of questions.

Perhaps you also have questions like these about God's will for your life, but I encourage you not to be overwhelmed. God wants you to accomplish His will more than you do!

Here are three tips from the Bible to help you remain in the will of God:



## 1. Study scriptures that say this is the will of God.

When you take the time to go through Scripture and yield yourself to walk in the clear, objective will of God-meaning those things specifically stated in the Bible, then the subjective will—those things the Scripture doesn't state directly—becomes clear to you.

This isn't about vowing to achieve God's will in your own strength. If you'll draw on His grace, you will access His ability to do the objective will of God that your flesh can't do, and you will find the subjective answers you seek.

## 2. Give thanks in everything.

First Thessalonians 5:16–18 says, "Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." Not everything that happens to you is God's will, but giving of thanks in the midst of all that happens to you is!

Consider the example of the Apostle Paul when he obeyed God to go and minister in Macedonia. Where did he end up? Beaten and thrown in jail! But when Paul began to thank and praise God, the prison doors flew open, his chains were loosed, and the jailer and his entire family got saved (Acts 16:9–10 and 19–36).

You can be in the middle of God's geographic and vocational will, just like Paul, and still not be in the will of God until you start giving God thanks.



### 3. Shake the devil off!

Once again, Paul was thrown into jail while doing God's will in Jerusalem. Imprisoned on a ship, a storm came, and the ship was wrecked (Acts 27)! After making it to an island, a snake bit him. At that point, most of us would start complaining. But what did Paul do? He shook the snake off into the fire and took no harm (Acts 28:1-5)! You need to be like Paul and shake the devil off.

Brothers and sisters, if you take these three tips to heart, I believe you will remain in God's will. Don't let Satan take you out of the objective will of God while you're seeking the subjective will of God. As you practice these principles, your answers are sure to come!



## FIRM FOUNDATIONS

Did you know that there is no factual evidence supporting the idea that humans descended from apes? Scientists have never observed one species transforming into another. Yet evolution is widely taught in schools and has a significant impact on impressionable children, despite the absence of scientific evidence.

The idea that life came from nothing, called spontaneous generation, has long been disproved and goes against several scientific laws—including the law of cause and effect, the law of conservation of energy/mass, and the law of entropy increase. Evolutionary theory is not science but a rejection of God.

Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts. . . . For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water.

2 Peter 3:3 and 5, emphasis added

To be willingly ignorant indicates that something is known but is rejected and discarded without serious thought. When people embrace the lie of evolution and reject the fact of God, the Bible calls them fools.

Sadly, there are many church leaders who have compromised on this issue by either accepting evolution or reasoning that God uses evolution. But they are perverting the truth and deceiving many people. That's why having a biblical worldview is so important!

Having a biblical worldview means seeing the world the way the Bible teaches us to see it. It tells us that God created everything in heaven and on earth, things we can see and things we can't see.

For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him.

Colossians 1:16


In Genesis 1, it says multiple times that God gave every creature of the land, sea, and air the ability to reproduce after its kind. While certain aspects of the Bible are symbolic, it is always crucial that we approach the Bible literally. When the Bible declares that God created the heaven and the earth on the first day (Gen. 1:1 and 5), it is not using symbolism.

The key to walking in victory in these last days is a worldview grounded in God's Word.

Everything around us shows that there is a Creator who made the world and everything in it, and He is guiding us with His wisdom and love. By being guided by that love, and understanding what the Bible teaches

us about life's origins and our purpose, we can safeguard our faith and communicate truth with compassion to a confused and hurting world.

## FROM HOPELESSNESS TO LEGACY:

The Inspiring Journeys of Will and Tony Dungy

Ever felt hopeless?

Will Dungy had every chance to feel that way. Despite serving in World War II, earning a doctorate, and becoming a teacher, he was banned from riding public buses and teaching at white schools as a 1950s black man. In a hopeless time, Will's faith in God led him to impact generations in unimaginable ways.

To make the situation better, Will poured his heart into academically preparing his students to shine on the day of integration and influenced many lives. But his son, Tony Dungy, became his greatest legacy.

As a black teenager during the 1960s, Tony faced challenges much like his father, but as a talented athlete. When Martin Luther King Jr., champion of equal rights, was tragically assassinated, many athletes protested by refusing to stand during the national anthem at games. Tony sought his father's guidance on whether to join his teammates in protest.

Anchored in his faith, Will advised him not to follow the crowd but to make a difference in his own unique way. Inspired, Tony decided to stand for the national anthem during games while bowing his head in prayer.

Tony's journey through life was marked by numerous obstacles. He could have easily given in to the pressures, but fueled by his father's faith, he overcame them allI

Desiring to play football with the best, Tony had hopes of joining the National Football League. After being drafted by the Steelers, he switched positions to accommodate white players, bench-warmed until filling in for two injured quarterbacks, and was later fired from coaching for his perceived "weak" biblical leadership tactics.

Despite setbacks, his sportsmanship and exceptional character eventually promoted him to become the first African American head coach to win a Super Bowl! Tony defied the odds, and it all began with the Christian advice he received from his father.

When Tony and his Super Bowlwinning team went to meet the President at the White House, his dad rode in the front seat of the bus. That was his biggest win!

Teresa felt prompted by the Holy Spirit to stop taking her medication. Embracing her authority as a believer, she boldly commanded all symptoms to leave her body. And sure enough, her symptoms began to gradually disappear one by one!

Because she heard Andrew's teaching that day, she learned how to make the finished work of the cross more real in her spirit than the symptoms in her physical body. Today, Teresa is completely healed!

## The story of Rukia Nanyonga

Rukia, currently a third-year student of Charis Bible College and a Partner of Andrew Wommack Ministries is a single mother of one biological child and three other children. In addition, she also caters for her sibling. She narrates her journey from being a person who used to worry about finances to learning how to trust God financially and being a faithful steward.

Rukia born Muslim, at about the age of 8 years gave her life to Christ while she was visiting at her aunt's home. When she got back home, due to fear of her parents, she continued practicing Islam until the age of 20 years when she left home and was able to fully embrace Christianity.

In 2018, a friend invited her to listen to a visiting American Evangelist at a local church in Kasubi who turned out to be Andrew Wommack. An invitation to enroll at Charis Bible College was made, but she did not enroll nor even consider because her attitude was that it was too high, she shunned it!

Rukia was a regular church going Christian without proper understanding of the Word. Her mindset towards giving to God was an investment which should carry returns on investment. She would give and then irritably wait for the return of good measure - a very frustrating process! She worried about budgets and saved small amounts to plan for unforeseen sickness!

During the lockdown while listening to the translated broadcasts of Andrews' teachings on Spirit FM, she felt herself grow closer to God. She wanted to give herself wholly to serve God, but she had no knowledge on how! She was also struggling to make progress in life. The testimonies she heard on radio stirred her up and she decided to visit the college on the open campus days. She was opting for a part-time less costly program but felt The Lord was



leading her to enroll for full time.

During the chapel sessions, she listened to a financial teaching called Financial Stewardship by Andrew. An invitation to partner with the Ministry was made and she decided to partner. Andrew had mentioned that "whatever is not enough, is seed enough to be sown!" which led Rukia to give.

After listening to the Power of Partnership audio teaching which she received as a partner, her attitude towards money and finances changed as she drew more from the principles of stewardship and co-laboring with God.

Currently, Rukia owns a stationary shop. She literally invited God into the business, and her business began to gr0w to her amazement! Revenues increased. Her monthly sales raised from way below to Ush1,500,000/- per month. In the shortest time possible, they continued to shoot higher to Ush1,800,000/- sales per month. Ideas of new products flowed to her from God, which products she introduced into her stocks! New streams of income came up as people reached out to be trained by her. Since then, Rukia increased her sowing into the Kingdom through community outreaches and teaching the communities to look to God for finances and financial increase. Her tithing has been transformed into a joy as she gives with a cheerful heart towards The Father's Kingdom.
