Living in the Balance of



One of the questions I get asked the most is "How do I receive from God?" People usually follow that up with "I've been praying, reading my Bible, going to church, and paying my tithes. I've been doing everything the Bible says to do." What they don't realize is that when they do that, they've just told me why they don't receive: they think their performance should earn them something from God. This is a misunderstanding of the balance of grace and faith and their relationship to each other.

The word grace means unmerited, undeserved favor. It's important to understand that grace has nothing to do with you earning anything from God. Grace existed long before you ever came to be. To put it simply, grace is God's part. Faith is your positive response to what God has already provided by grace. In other words, faith is basically your way of saying yes to God's grace. Faith only appropriates what God has already provided for you. Therefore, faith is your part.

Grace and faith work together, and they must be in balance.

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:8–9

Sometimes we read a passage from Scripture that is so familiar, we don't stop to think about what it is really saying. In this verse, a profound truth is being declared. It says that we are saved by grace through faith—not one or the other. Think of it this way: **Grace is what God does. Faith is what we do**. It takes both working together for us to receive salvation, healing, or anything else from God.

Salvation is not dependent on grace alone. If it were, everyone would be saved and going to heaven, because God's grace is the same toward everyone.

For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men.

Titus 2:11

God has already given the gift of salvation to everyone through Jesus. It is by faith that a person receives what Jesus accomplished through His death, burial, and resurrection 2,000 years ago.

Most of us believe that in order to be saved, we need to ask God to forgive us of our sins, but that isn't what the Bible teaches. In 1 John 2:2, it states that Jesus was the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours, but also for the sins of the whole world. Jesus didn't just die for those He knew would accept Him; He died for every sinner who has ever lived on this earth. And He died before you or I ever committed a single sin.

Here is a radical truth that would get me kicked out of most churches: **sin is not an issue with God**. The Lord isn't waiting for us to ask Him to forgive us of our sins. The sins of the entire world—past, present, and





future—have already been forgiven. Even a man like Adolf Hitler had grace extended to him! Jesus loved Hitler and paid for his sins just as He did for yours and mine. God is no respecter of persons (Rom. 2:11).

God has already done His part; it is now up to you to receive the truth by faith and make it a reality in your life. Amen!

God's grace has provided not only for salvation but also for every need in your life. That provision is not based on whether you are reading the Bible enough, praying enough, going to church, or even paying your tithes. Before you ever had a financial need, God created the provision. Before you were sick, God, through grace, provided your healing (1 Pet. 2:24). Before you ever became discouraged, God blessed you with all spiritual blessings (Eph. 1:3). God anticipated every need you could ever have and met those needs through Jesus before you existed. That's the grace of God.

Jesus hasn't saved, healed, delivered, or prospered a single person in the last 2,000 years. What God provided by grace 2,000 years ago now becomes a reality when a person mixes their faith with it. Faith appropriates what God has already provided. Faith doesn't move God; He isn't the one who is stuck. Faith doesn't make God do anything. Grace and faith work together, and our part is to accept what God has already done. Grace must be balanced with faith.

It is not the truth that sets you free; it's the truth you know that sets you free (John 8:32). And the truth is, you need to put your faith in what God has already done, not in what you do.

God has done His part by giving His Son, Jesus. His grace has provided everything through the sacrifice of Jesus. **This is nearly too good to be true because there is absolutely nothing we can do to earn it and nothing we can do to lose it**. Our part is simple: we respond to His grace by faith and appropriate what has already been accomplished.

As simple as this sounds, most Christians don't understand this concept. Many emphasize grace, and others emphasize faith. But too few emphasize balancing grace and faith. This is what the Bible teaches, but sad to say, many people get into error on this. It's like sodium and chloride: Taken individually, both are poisons and can kill you. When mixed together, they become salt, which you must have to live.


Grace without your positive response of faith won't save you, and faith that isn't a response to God's grace will bring you into condemnation. But if you put your faith in what God has already done for you, you'll have the victory that overcomes the world (1 John 5:4). This is absolutely foundational to your relationship with God and could be the reason that you may not be seeing your prayers answered.

BEHIND THE SCENES: AWM TV AND LIVE-STREAM STUDIO

Have you ever wondered how Andrew Wommack Ministries adapted during the challenges of the pandemic era? Over the last three years, something extraordinary took place. As the world faced isolation and fear, AWM and Charis Bible College began reaching people through digital technology like never before. From a mere two live streams per week, the ministry output has multiplied to an astonishing fifty per month, with content that's continuously expanding and improving.

Today, we invite you to venture behind the scenes and uncover the studios where these shows come to life!

In addition to Andrew's daily Gospel Truth program, we also film for our other productions, including The Inside Story, Biblical Worldview, and many more. We have an entire special projects team responsible for AWM en Español (our Spanish broadcast) as well as our Charis University teaching series and Biblical Worldview series.

Our production team is the creative force behind all of Andrew's live streams, including the international Grace & Faith live streams as well as the monthly *Inside Story* editions. And our stories and news team brings to life captivating videos like *Destiny Stories*, *Grace Encounters*, and our construction updates.

THE DAILY GOSPEL TRUTH PROGRAM

Around 1999, executive producer Stephen Bransford started praying for a professional studio set that would accurately represent Andrew. Drawing inspiration from a Christmas TV special featuring beautiful mountain décor, Stephen brought together these elements to create the studio we recognize today.

Another fun fact is that Andrew films four weeks of his daily *Gospel Truth* television programs in just two days. For each TV shoot day, the daily broadcast team films ten 25-minute shows in about five to six hours. The primary TV studio has always used one camera to film Andrew's program, which preserves the intimate one-on-one connection with the audience. Although we now have ten cameras and two control rooms to do the various daily filming needed, Andrew's daily show is still filmed with just one camera.

A friend of Andrew's gave him most of the items that furnish his studio, including the Presidents' pictures, the American flag, and the antlers, wagon wheels, chaps, potbellied stove, saddle, and most of the cowboy paraphernalia. Andrew contributed a pair of his own boots, and the large oval buffalo rug hanging over the railing is Jamie's.

Another interesting set piece is the wooden stairs and beam. These actually came from the 2002 Hayman Fire and were put together by one of our employees.

ANDREW'S TV STUDIO

Andrew's TV set has remained virtually unchanged throughout the years and is made of long-lasting materials like natural wood and stone. The set you see today was originally built at our Colorado Springs location. When that property was sold, the set was carefully dismantled, transported to Woodland Park, and reassembled when the ministry moved into its new AWM Headquarters building.



CHARIS TV PRODUCTION DEPARTMENT

Charis also has a Production Department and produces programs like Carrie Pickett's *Life Foundations, Charis Relationship University,* Healing Now, Charis Daily Live Bible Study, and more.

THE LIVE-STREAM STUDIOS

The live studio production team, once three members strong, has expanded to seventeen members, including producers, engineers, and tech support specialists.

The Charis Daily Live Bible Study and Truth & Liberty Live Call-In Show, originally weekly live streams, now air Monday through Friday worldwide. The control rooms, studios, and sets have been adapted to accommodate the ministry's rapid growth, with the team constantly creating, innovating, and planning for the future.



CHARIS DAILY LIVE BIBLE STUDY

The Charis Daily Live Bible Study, initially filmed at the AWM TV studio, faced scheduling conflicts. A set was then built at Charis Woodland Park, but due to sustainability issues, office space at AWM Headquarters was converted into a new studio.

THE TRUTH & LIBERTY LIVE CALL-IN SHOW

The *Truth & Liberty* show also added some challenging logistics due to the nature of live call-ins. But production teams were up to the task, creating an incredible way for viewers to connect directly with the hosts, ask questions, and receive biblically sound answers. Remote studios are also being set up to enable host Alex McFarland to take live calls from his studio across the country!

MORE ON THE HORIZON

With a "yes" continuously in their heart for Andrew Wommack, the AWM Media Department is constantly innovating, learning, and developing to ensure they are as prepared as possible for whatever comes next.

As we continue to reach farther and deeper with the Gospel, more and more lives will be impacted and changed by the message of God's unconditional love and grace. Thank you, partners and friends!

THE REAL PURPOSE OF THE LAW: **DEMYSTIFYING GOD'S TRUE NATURE**

The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. 1 Corinthians 15:56

If you don't understand the purpose of something, you may ultimately end up misusing it and then abusing it. That's certainly what happened with the Law of Moses. This lack of understanding has led to many being misled about God's true nature, thinking He is angry and harsh.

People often ask themselves, "Which is it? Is He the harsh God of judgment found in the Old Testament, or the God of grace found in the New?"

Yet time and time again, we see that God's Word declares He is the same yesterday, today, and forever (Heb. 13:8).

For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed. Malachi 3:6

It's important that we rectify these two seemingly contrary truths. Because if we don't settle within our hearts that God's true nature is good, we'll struggle to trust Him. Trust is key in any relationship. A relationship without trust will end up being unhealthy, with each person wondering if they can believe the words that the other person says.

Trust is also essential for faith to operate, which is how we as believers are to live our lives: "The just shall live by faith" (Rom. 1:17). Faith is how we receive all the promises of God, and without faith it is impossible to please Him (Heb. 11:6).

The real reason God gave the Law was to show mankind their sin and inability to measure up so that they would recognize their need for a Savior. Romans 5:13 says, "For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law."

Before the Law, Noah and Abraham were counted as righteous because they believed God (Gen. 6:8–9 and 15:6). And God didn't deal with them according to their sin but according to His mercy. They wouldn't have been able to put their faith in God had they not trusted Him with all their heart.

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Proverbs 3:5-6

God does not have two contradictory natures. He has only one nature that is good. As you dive deeper into the Scriptures, I pray that you will see the Old Covenant

in light of what Jesus did for you on the cross. He had to show mankind that apart from God, they were dead in their sins and without hope in the world (Rom. 3:23 and Eph. 2:12).

THE DOCTORS SAID NO, BUT GOD SAID YES.

Can you imagine medical personnel telling you that a quick drug overdose is your best option?

Well, that's what happened to Johnny Rhodes.

Johnny spent eleven years working to become an emergency medical doctor but then spiraled into a deep-rooted pattern of alcoholism and drug addiction. Losing his medical license, he ended up homeless and knew he had to get serious help.

After bouncing from counselor to psychiatrist to other medical professionals, Johnny was ultimately diagnosed with several disorders, including depression and post-traumatic stress disorder. The consensus of several counselors was that Johnny's condition was incurable and his only escape was through death.

Johnny's addictive behavior continued, eventually landing him in jail. It seemed all hope was lostuntil he was born again during his confinement.

This divine encounter didn't immediately solve Johnny's problems, but it was the catalyst for the biggest transformation he would ever experience.

You might wonder, Why was Johnny struggling in the first place? A victim of repeated sexual abuse as a child, he began to become extremely angry. At his core, he felt he was a fundamentally bad person and that God was mad at him. To numb the pain, he turned to drugs and alcohol.

Years later, in and out of treatment centers, Johnny couldn't seem to maintain a grasp on freedom. But during his fifteenth attempt at rehab, something major happened. The rehab center was a faithbased facility, and the people there had something that Johnny was missing—confidence in the love of God. When a mentor gave him Andrew Wommack's book Self Centeredness: The Source of All Grief,

Johnny was far from thrilled. The title felt insulting to him, but God knew what He was doing.

After reading the book, God downloaded to Johnny the first step to his transformation. In a vision, the name Andrew Wommack appeared in big neon letters and the word school dropped into his spirit. What did this mean?

Surprisingly, Johnny discovered from a friend that Andrew Wommack had a Bible college in Woodland Park, Colorado. Instantly, Johnny knew God was lighting the way for his total recovery.

Johnny and his wife, Jeannie, obeyed God to attend Charis Bible College, and the result was nothing short of miraculous. After thirty years of addiction, Johnny encountered God's unconditional love for the first time. The lies that had held him back and the shackles of deep childhood trauma instantly lost their power, and he became rock solid in his relationship with God.

After he received personal confirmation from the Holy Spirit, Johnny flushed all his medications down the toilet and hasn't looked back. The doctors said no, but God said yes!

Partners and friends, we can't take the credit for this story. Because of God's faithfulness and your support, Johnny and countless others are experiencing emotional healing

through Andrew Wommack Ministries and Charis. What you're doing through your financial giving is amazing, and we can't thank you enough.

Have you ever felt inadequate to do all God has called you to do?

I did.

When I was a little girl, I was talentless. If you had met me then, you would have never believed that I would be who I am today—a creative arts director and performer.

But here I am.

If you want to overcome inadequacy and fulfill God's plan, here are three things that you must do:

#1 Ask God to show you His vision. My parents were both missionaries. I have always known about God. But I was amazed as a five-year-old when my Sunday school teacher told me that if I talked to Him, He would talk back. I went home, jumped in bed, pulled the covers over my head, and asked God to show me the future that He had for me. I was completely blown away. I would preach the Gospel as a filmmaker and performer!

If you ask God to show you His vision for your life, He will (Jer. 33:3).

#2 Believe what God shows you. I didn't doubt that God could do everything He showed me as a child, but it was my lack of talent I was worried about. My singing was so bad that I got kicked out of the children's choir! I didn't understand when or how God would grant me the ability to perform, but I knew He would. When God shows you His plan, believe it (Heb. 11:6).

#3 Recognize that you've already got it. There was an elderly lady at my church who prayed every service for God to use her. When she died, I feared that God would forget about me the way she seemed forgotten. For two weeks, I locked myself in my room, waiting for God to give me the talent I needed to serve Him. Surprisingly, after I was done complaining, He corrected me.

"Have I given you hands, feet, a head, and a heart?" He asked. God had already provided every tool I needed, including the Holy Spirit, to help me fulfill His will.

I was shocked. What I needed to succeed was in my possession the whole time (Eph. 1:3). I just needed to develop my talent. I started singing and performing at elderly homes and accepting invitations to smaller

projects. Until one day, God was able to use me in bigger capacities—much like the role I have today.

If you are in Christ, you have everything you need. But to succeed, you must exercise what you already have and walk out your purpose with the Holy Spirit.

Remember these three things, and I promise that you, too, can overcome inadequacy and fulfill your calling!

Not only did God bring the Murens, but He also brought the Olofsson family from Sweden at around the same time. Jakob Olofsson orchestrates all the music for the productions, making the beautiful sounds that captivate people's hearts. Both families were drawn to the lifechanging truth taught by Andrew Wommack.

Jakob shares, "We came here for Charis Bible College. We didn't come for the musicals because none of that was here. Before we left Sweden, I worked as a percussionist in orchestras, but I sold everything pertaining to my job as a percussionist to come to Charis. **There needs to be a clear ending for a new beginning to take place. This was our clear ending that led to a completely new beginning.**"

God's hand in bringing the musicals to life at Andrew Wommack Ministries and Charis didn't stop there.

Next, God brought Ivar Muren. Ivar plays a large role in filming and editing the productions.

Ivar says, "I just knew that I wanted at least a year with the Word of God, and this opportunity opened up at Charis. I was never really interested in videography, editing, or anything like that. But when you look beyond what you already know and start searching and challenging yourself to go outside of your comfort zone, then you can conquer new areas." I believe that the best thing you can do is to start walking where you are. The key is to do what Ivar and Jakob have done. Be faithful in the little and get out of your comfort zone, stop living for yourself, and start living for a greater cause. The journey is the most important thing, because He's guiding you and teaching you what you need to learn.

As Christians, our sense of peace depends not on our outward circumstances but on our inward thoughts. If we think on the negative things of this world, we are going to be depressed because the things of this world are depressing. But if we think on the positive things of God, put our minds on heavenly things, and think about what God has given us, we are going to be blessed. It all depends on where we put our minds.

Where is your mind? Isaiah 26:3 reveals, "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee."


If we really had our minds stayed on the awesome things God has done for us and has prepared for us, it would be impossible for us to be depressed and defeated, regardless of our present situation. There would be perfect peace. One of the reasons the Lord told us about the future and of the glories He has planned for us is because when we are in the middle of negative circumstances, we can close our eyes and think on these things (Phil. 4:8). We can think about our glorious future. We can think about the fact that this physical life is like a brief millisecond compared to eternity. And as we begin to think on these things, it will bring emotional peace and joy to us. We will find our peace in who we are in Christ and in what He's done for us, not in our physical circumstances.

Your mind—what you think about—controls your emotions. I could tell ten different people the exact same thing, and their emotional reactions would vary, depending on how they perceived what I said to them. Some might believe what I said; some might not. But they have all, in some way, preprogrammed themselves to respond a certain way.

We think differently, and emotions follow thought. So if we begin controlling the way we think based on the Word of God, then we can begin controlling the way we feel.

RE-BIRTHING OF A VISION



For Christopher formerly known as Sharif Abdullatif, Charis has not only been a place of restoration but also a rebirth of a vision! Christopher, a third-year student at Charis Bible College and one of our international students from Tanzania was born in a staunch Muslim family of parents who both visited Mecca. But for Christopher, through the influence of Christian friends, he fell out of love with Islam and wanted nothing to do with a mosque!

In 2013, he accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior and his family rejected him rendering him homeless! He soon turned his homelessness into an opportunity to help street children. Later that year, he founded World Changer Ministry which flourished. In 2015, he got partners from Germany. It is also in that same year that he got baptized and changed names from Abdullatif to Christopher.

In 2019 a friend on the ministry team betrayed him because the ministry was attracting lots of funding! He lost the ministry to this friend and went into a depression, later seeking work in the Tours & Travel industry just to survive and take care of himself.

He knew that there was more to Christianity. There was a deep drive and heart hunger in him which led him to search the internet for Bible Colleges where he would be taught. He found a lot of information about different Bible colleges in East Africa, but something about Charis Bible College caught his eye. It was the address of the headquarters in Colorado which drew him because he believed he was destined for America.

He called the ministry in Uganda and made his way to the Uganda Campus to find out more. To his disappointment the American flag was nowhere in sight. This disappointment was lifted off when he saw the flag in one of the classes as he was being shown around. He then knew he was home.

He returned to Tanzania and sold all his belongings to set off for Uganda. While a full-time 1st year day student, he received a call from his betrayer seeking reconciliation and offering him a percentage settlement! He negotiated and an initial payment was made which he used to pay his Tuition for the 3 years of study. He hoped to use the subsequent instalments for his upkeep. However, they did not come through as promised and this left him in a financial bind.

found a cheaper place of aboard where he could also walk to school and sit under the Word of God. He gave himself totally to The Word in 1st year. In 2nd year, he learnt about Money, Media and Ministry, which stirred his vision. He went on a mission trip later that year and his desire to start ministry was fully rebirthed causing him to start a Ministry that he called Show Jesus Ministry!

Through attending the 3rd year leadership class, he learnt about ministry and business and how to be a leader-manager. It dawned on him that the reason he had lost his earlier ministry was due to ignorance of the Godly order of ministry! His ministry is now fully registered in Jinja with 12 fully sponsored children. He now has Partners in Europe and was able to visit them in Germany for a month where he was invited for speaking engagements. He also got to meet his former donors, who have since invited him to their ministry meetings. He gladly obliged since he forgave and has found complete healing through Charis teachings and is gladly offering the wise counsel that he has received.
