TAKING THE LIMITS OFF GOD THROUGH YOUR IMAGINATION



A big part of my personal testimony is a result of when God taught me about the power of imagination and not limiting Him. I got born again when I was eight years old. As an adult in 1968, I had an encounter with the Lord that made me realize what a religious hypocrite I was, and I repented. I expected God's wrath and judgment, but instead He showered me with supernatural love for four and a half months.

During that time, I felt God telling me to share with others what I learned about identity and grace. So, I started heading in that direction, but there was a lot of frustration. It wasn't God causing the frustration; it was all of the junk that was inside of me that was hindering the Lord from flowing through me.

In 2000, God told me to go on TV, and things started to improve. By 2002, the ministry had doubled in size, so I was on the right path. But then the Lord spoke to me through Psalm 78, which is a retelling of what God

did with the Israelites when they left Egypt and how they just constantly turned around and rebelled at Him.

How oft did they provoke him in the wilderness, and grieve him in the desert! Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and limited the Holy One of Israel.

Psalm 78:40–41

God had nothing but good plans for the Israelites (Jer 29:11) and wanted to bring them out of Egypt and into the land He had promised them, but they just wouldn't cooperate. Every time they ran into a hard place, they'd start complaining and talking about dying in the wilderness and wishing they could go back to Egypt.

God was trying to bring them into something better, but they just constantly hindered what He wanted them to do. Notice that it says they often provoked Him, and turned back and tempted the Holy One of Israel.

On January 31, 2002, the Lord spoke Psalm 78:41 to me, and it's probably the second-most-important encounter I've ever had with the Lord as far as the results that it made in my ministry. He told me, "You're limiting what I can do through you with your small thinking." Even though I knew what God wanted for my life and believed I'd reach people worldwide, I realized I was limiting Him in many ways. The biggest way was that I knew His plan, but I couldn't picture it or see myself doing those things.

After years of rejection, I'd gotten used to people not liking me. Surprisingly, in the last decade, things changed, and I started being accepted by the same people who used to reject me. It felt really weird because I







wasn't used to it. But after decades of thinking small and not imagining the big things God was giving me vision for, I knew I had to confront it, but I was fearful of seeming proud.

Those past rejections made me keep my dreams quiet, even from Jamie. It was hard for me to see myself reaching a lot of people, but I knew God wanted my ministry to be huge. So, I had to stop limiting what God could do in my life and start seeing the big picture He had in mind for me. And the events that unfolded as a result are nothing short of miraculous.

In 2002, we had 25 staff, and now we have a team of around 1,200. That's a forty-eight-fold increase! Our income has increased by fiftyone times, reaching over \$100 million per year in the U.S. alone, with an additional \$30 million supporting our twenty-two global offices. All this incredible growth unfolded in just twenty-one years. It's truly been an explosive journey.

The turning point wasn't that all of a sudden God started moving. God was moving all along. My own limited thinking and fear of judgment had created a dam in my life because I had been holding back, hesitant to express what God had placed in my heart. But once I broke free from that small mindset, it was like a dam breaking, unleashing the flood of God's intended blessings. And one of the major catalysts to this was using my imagination.

You cannot see anything happen on the outside that you haven't seen happen on the inside. That's a big statement right there. You might be praying for your marriage to be restored, for your body to be healed, or for financial prosperity, but you need to meditate on the Word and let it paint a picture on the inside of you. Then whatever you're believing for will come to pass. It's a self-fulfilling prophecy.

The point I'm making is that you can't function without an imagination. Very few people allow the Word of God and His promises to dominate their thinking. Most people have a negative, fearful mindset and limit what God can do. But God has so much more for each and every one of us.

Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

2 Corinthians 2:14

If you're living in a way that shrinks what God can do in and through you, you've got to read the living Word of God and allow Him to speak to you through it. And then at some point you've got to move beyond just reading to visualizing the manifestation through your imagination. You've got to see yourself healthy and prosperous. Your life is a reflection of your vision!


For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he. Proverbs 23:7a

SEVEN MAJOR LIES TO REJECT ABOUT MARRIAGE



When Adam and Eve encountered Satan in the garden, his aim was not only to ruin their relationship with God but also to sow discord between them. The devil has been intent on destroying marriage since the beginning!

Here are seven lies prevalent in our culture today about family and marriage:

Lie #1: Marriage is just a piece of paper.

The Truth: Marriage is a sacred institution, ordained by Almighty God, where a man leaves his parents to become one with his wife (Gen. 2:24 and Eph. 5:31).

Lie #2: Marriage is a system of oppression against women.

The Truth: There's nothing more important than raising children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. It's deeply fulfilling (Prov. 31:10-30).

Lie #3: It's a sin to have children due to concerns about overpopulation.

The Truth: The entire eight billion global population could fit into Texas with a density of 30,000 people per square mile. This is lower than Manhattan's current population density of nearly 71,000 people per square mile. There's plenty of space (Gen. 1:28)!

Lie #4: It's a sin to have children in the face of climate change.

The Truth: This earth is wounded by sin, and cataclysmic weather events will continue because of sin (Rom. 8:21-22). Lie #5: Marriage and the traditional family unit is outdated. But if you do happen to get pregnant, you can abort, because it's not a child.

The Truth: Every person reading this was once a developing fetus. At what point was it not you? It was always you at every stage of development (Ps. 139:16). Life and marriage are sacred!

Lie #6: Children don't need both a mother and father to raise them.

The Truth: God's plan involves one man and one woman in the holy bonds of matrimony to bring up their children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, teaching them God's will for family, sexuality, and overall conduct (Eph. 6:1-4).

Lie #7: There's really no such thing as gender anyway.

The Truth: There are only two genders. God made them male and female (Gen. 1:27).

In John 17:17, Jesus said, "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth." The truth is, there are only two genders, and family stands as the most fundamental institution of society. Matrimony between a man and woman is the only legitimate form of marriage.

HOW TO MAKE THE TRUTHS OF HEAVEN A REALITY ON EARTH!

The Bible probably has over one thousand promises in it. The reason you're still here on this earth is so that you can live out every one of them. Do you know how to make the truths established in the heavenlies a reality in your life?

Here are three points to help you make the truths of heaven reality on earth:

#1 Remember your Creator. In Genesis 1:27, you will find the old familiar verse that says, "God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them." Now, don't just gloss over that. We were created to operate like our Creator—God. Since that's the case, then we can look at the creation verses in the first chapter of Genesis to see how we should act. How did He create the entire universe? By His words! If you were created in His likeness and image, and He placed that much value on what He spoke, then just how important is it to also recognize the power of your words?


#2 Recognize the power of your words. There are so many scriptures that express the importance of what you say. For instance, Proverbs 18:21 says, "Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof." Your words are so powerful that they can change the atmosphere. If you take a look at Romans 10:9–10, you will see that you have to confess with your mouth to even be saved! I am laying the foundation of just how important your words are so that you can recognize their true power. Jesus said that by your words you will be justified or you will be condemned (Matt. 12:37). If they aren't already, it's high time to get your words aligned with the Bible.



#3 Confess what the Word of God says. Psalm 119:89 tells us that the Word has been eternally settled in heaven. God's promises toward you are already yes and amen (2 Cor. 1:20). All things that pertain to life and godliness belong to you in Christ (2 Pet. 1:3)! Everything that God has promised is an absolute truth in the spiritual realm, but how do you get these truths from the heavenly realm into yours? Just like salvation, every promise was provided two thousand years ago at Calvary. You have to find what is written in the Word of God, believe it in your heart, and confess with your mouth (Mark 11:23) to experience it in your life.

If you want to make the truths of heaven a reality on earth, I hope you will remember these three points!




In Ruth's words, "We want to help other Christians rise up in their finances or come out of debt."

The only thing that makes something a big deal is our unbelief. We tend to

magnify how terrible our situation is. However, it would do you good just to look at things from God's perspective and realize that it's no big deal.

Jesus was walking on top of the very thing that was raging around the disciples, and they supposed it had been a spirit (Mark 6:49). In other words, they just couldn't believe that this wasn't bothering God. They couldn't believe that He wasn't struggling the same way they were. The disciples were probably thinking, Surely, this is some kind of vision coming toward us. It can't be real. Jesus can't walk on top of water. This isn't normal. It's not natural!

God isn't limited the way we are in the physical realm. Yet many times we really do think He is limited. I've been asked, "Have you ever heard of anybody being healed of AIDS before? I've heard of cancers being healed, but not AIDS." Nothing—absolutely nothing—is impossible with God! Of course He can handle AIDS! But we think, A million

dollars, five million dollars, a house payment, a car payment. This is just too big—even for God. We expect Him to feel like, "Hey, I just can't pull this off in such a short time. I need more time to do it." God isn't like that. He can walk on top of anything that's about to destroy us. We need to get used to God being supernatural!

Everyone struggles with this. Sometimes we live so much in the natural realm that it just seems like, "God, is there really a way out of this?" There's always a way out—nothing is too difficult for God. Whatever our problem is, Jesus is on top of it. He's not under it. He's not sinking. This is no problem for Jesus!

For they all saw him, and were troubled. And immediately he talked with them, and saith unto them, Be of good cheer: it is I; be not afraid.

Mark 6:50

This verse just shows how completely in control God is. The things that are bothering you aren't bothering God. And if you would appropriate what is yours in Christ, then you don't need to be bothered either. You really don't!

BROKENNESS TO BREAKTHROUGH



Mrs. Muhumuza Dorothy Kemigisha, a 2nd year graduate of Charis Bible College enrolled at the College in 2019 as Ms. Kemigisha Dorothy Joy. At the time, she was emotionally unwell, was battling with constant headaches, had a low self-esteem, and was just seeking a new direction for her life.

Her father, being an Alumni and part of the pioneer class of Charis Bible College Uganda, had started teaching his children Andrew Wommack's Discipleship Evangelism course from a tender age. As a result, Dorothy had been introduced to these foundational truths by the age of fourteen.

At High School, Dorothy had enrolled as a science student. She went through the two years S.5 to S.6 as a leader of the Scripture Union. At the end of the two years, she was unable to make the required grades and was advised to switch to Arts and re-do the 2 years. She painfully obeyed, and this was when the feelings of shame and unworthiness began. She wondered why God had allowed this and yet she was serving Him. As if that was not enough, her peers moved on and she was separated from the relationships of friendships she had built. This turn of events took an emotional toll on her.

In 2017, while re-doing her high school, Dorothy was elected as the Head girl of the school and this leadership position also came with a lot of pressure. As the academic and leadership stress piled up, she slipped into memory loss, insomnia, and had to be medicated for her to sleep! The memory loss was found to be temporal, but she was later diagnosed with bi-polar disorder. During this time of her downward spiral, her father kept playing Andrew Wommack's videos of the Healing Journeys.

In 2018, Andrew Wommack visited Uganda and Dorothy attended his Gospel Truth Seminar (GTS). By this time, she was on her path to recovery and was coming off most of her medication. Her attending of the GTS sealed her decision to enroll at Charis Bible College. Andrew had mentioned that the devil cannot give people a desire to go to Bible college and this statement was a confirmation that the Lord was calling her to sit under His Word and be taught.

In 2019, she decided to enroll at Charis Bible College when she was supposed to be proceeding to a higher institution of learning. Her father was very supportive of her decision and although the family experienced some financial setbacks that affected Dorothy's continuation, a friend of the family offered to sponsor her and in 2022 she returned as a 1st year student.

As she sat under the Word of God, as a student at Charis, all the headaches and emotional instabilities dissolved effortlessly, and she soon joined the CBC worship team, and was recognized as one of the most outstanding students in the course during her stay.

She met Mr. Muhumuza, who would later become her husband, at Charis Bible College in 2019 when she first enrolled. She graduated in October of 2023 and got married the following month.

Dorothy's story has been transformed from that of brokenness to break through. She has been rebuilt by the Word, found her identity in Christ, and no longer doubts God's love for her. She is daily growing her relationship with God and has formed better relationships with the people around her. She has found purpose and has come to understand that God wants a relationship with her and not religion!
