CHRISTIAN PHILOSOPHY

Every person views their life through a filter. For example, optimists see opportunity in every situation they face, while pessimists can only see defeat and failure. Both could be facing the same circumstances, but their filter determines how they respond. That filter could also be called their philosophy.



A philosophy is simply a way of thinking. And whether you know it or not, the direction that your life is going has been influenced and controlled by your personal philosophy, or your dominant way of thinking. Proverbs 23:7 says, *“For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he.”* If that is true—and it is—then it makes sense to be sure that you are viewing your life through the right filter.

Colossians 2:8 says, *“Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.”*

In this scripture, Paul was giving the believers in Colosse a warning. The word *beware* is being used in the sense of a sentry on guard duty. It's a military term talking about being on guard, being on the lookout. And the word *spoil* is not talking about food; it's talking about the spoils of war that go to the victor—the gold and silver and land.

Paul was saying to be on guard lest the believers be overcome by an enemy that would strip them of their treasure, which was the truth that God had placed in their hearts. Today, that same enemy, the devil, wants to steal what God has given to you, using the world's philosophies and the religious traditions of man.

Your life follows the direction of your thoughts. The key is to renew your mind with a Christian perspective—a Christian philosophy. Your outlook acts as a filter, helping you see the positive. A Christian philosophy or viewpoint allows you to focus on the positive and operate in faith rather than fear when others are afraid. So, it's important that your philosophy is based on the truth of God's Word.

It's through the subtle deception of human philosophy that Satan tries to deceive us. The first example of this can be found in Genesis 3:1–5.

Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

Now, think about this: It says that the serpent was more *“subtil.”* The word *subtle* basically means crafty, sly, and devious. Satan wasn't using a frontal attack to overpower Adam and Eve; he was attempting to change their way of thinking, their philosophy. Before the devil can get us into any type of deception, he has to move us away from the Word of God and get us to where we compromise our confidence and our faith in the Word of God.

Adam and Eve began with a pure philosophy. They were completely dependent upon God and never questioned His wisdom and goodness. Satan first caused them to question God's Word, and then he caused them to question God's goodness. He beguiled them, which is what Paul was writing about in 2 Corinthians 11:3: *“But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.”*

Satan has never changed his tactics. He is at work through our society and culture trying to create a philosophy that is contrary to God's Word. He is always trying to devalue the finished work of Jesus and His Word. Sad to say, it's working. Even most Christians today do not have their belief systems firmly in place. They are influenced more by culture, social media, movies, their upbringing, or the opinions of others than by the Word of God.

Many of you reading this know what the Scripture says. You have read that God wants you to prosper and be in health even as your soul prospers. You have read that by His stripes, you were healed and that Jesus came to give you life more abundantly. Yet when you look in the mirror, you see a failure, a loser, or a sick and defeated person. Why is that?

It's because of your core philosophy. Maybe your parents told you that you would never amount to anything, or a previous mate convinced you that you were worthless. Or perhaps a religious leader told you that you were cursed because of your behavior, and you believed him or her. Whatever the root cause for your belief (philosophy), you are being spoiled, and your treasure is being stolen.

If that is you, then begin changing the way you think. Study and meditate in the Word of God and change your basic core beliefs. *"For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart"* (Heb. 4:12).

In my own life, as I began to change the way I thought, it opened the door to the blessings that God had for me all along. I was actually limiting God by my small thinking, my philosophy. You may be doing the same thing. If you are, don't waste any more time—change your mind.

Every believer needs to have a clear biblical philosophy, and it must be based solely on the Word of God. Without it, you will be tossed to and fro with every wind of doctrine.

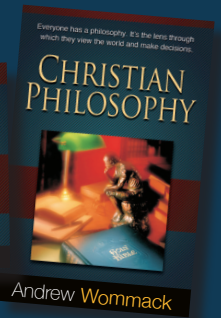
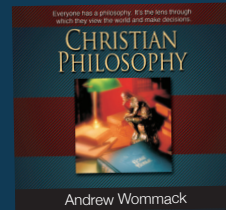
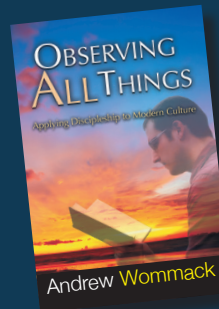

James 1:6-8

I'm just trying to tell you that our society today has become so intellectual and sophisticated that we think someone is absolutely stupid to just believe in the Word of God, use it as their foundation, and base their life on promises that were written thousands of years ago. 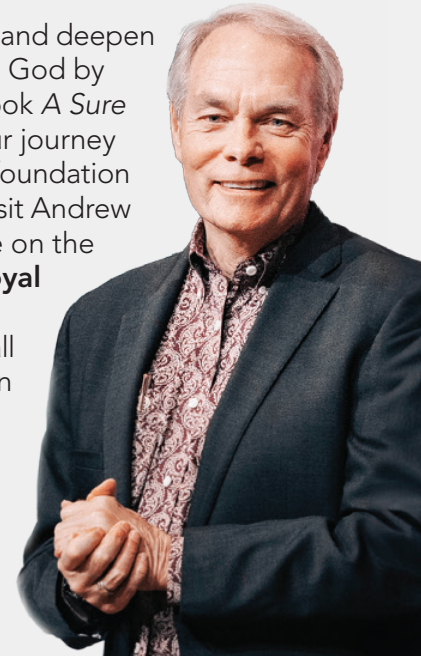
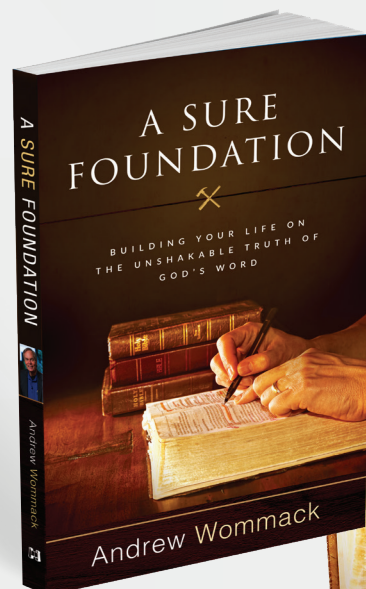
it perfectly, so I may not have perfect results. But to the degree that I have based my life on the Word of God, it's working. It's changing me, and it's setting me free.

Dear Partners and Friends,

I'm writing to you today to inform you about some major things going on in our ministry and ask for your prayers and agreement.

About a year ago, one of the television networks that airs my program gave me some criticism for something I taught. I listened and prayed about it, but I didn't say anything wrong. Then, another network put out a mandate for me to start doing something I do on my program as the Lord directs, but they said they were mandating it to be a part of every program. I communicated with them and we worked everything out, but that got me to thinking:

I am at the mercy of these networks and stations. This was a wake-up call. I could lose my ability to communicate through these networks anytime, at their discretion.

As you know, our nation is under demonic attack, and the Gospel is the greatest weapon we have in our arsenal. The devil is doing everything he can to silence the truth of God's Word, and thousands of churches are going woke. Even much of Christian media is "going along to get along." I need an avenue to keep speaking the Word without compromise that is not subject to someone else's censure. I believe the Lord wants me to create a network to protect the Gospel truth He has revealed to me.

I prayed about what I could do to protect the outreach the Lord has given me, and a number of things happened. But the end result was that **I decided to start my own TV network.**

I started moving in that direction last summer, but some new developments just happened that moved this way up on my priority list. I feel the Lord is prodding me to get this done quickly. We are putting a lot of effort into getting this new network, which I have named **Gospel Truth Network (GTN)**, up and running as soon as possible.

Now that we are moving in that direction, I can see that this will not only preserve my ability to share the Gospel, but it will amplify it. This will take my ministry to a whole new level. Instead of just a thirty-minute daily program, we will have the ability to share the Word 24 hours a day. This new network will eventually be available on Comcast, DirecTV, DISH, and all the outlets we now use through these other networks, and it will cost less than I'm paying now.

I do not plan on dropping any of the networks or individual stations that I'm currently airing on anytime in the near future. These stations and networks have taken years to build their audience. It will take us time to get the word out about GTN and also develop all the programs we are planning to air.

But this network will be a legacy move that will enable Charis Bible College and our related ministries to continue even after I'm gone. I feel an urgency to get this started by the end of this summer. We are moving full steam ahead.

We've already done some of the things necessary to accomplish this, but there is still a long way to go. *I'm asking you to pray with me and my staff for wisdom. We haven't been down this road before, and we need God's supernatural wisdom and guidance to get this done.*

Our September 2024 launch of this new Gospel Truth Network will not be a finished product. But you will see new sets, new programming, and 24 hours per day of uncompromised Gospel that will not be subject to anyone else's censure. At a time when we see churches and Christian leaders going woke and compromising our Christian values, I can assure you I'm not going to do that. This will become

a trusted source of godly material that will minister to individuals, families, and our culture, regardless of what others do. I'm excited about that.

We have plans for many of the anointed staff of Charis to create a variety of programs for all ages and interests—children, youth, and family ministry. We plan to roll out a variety of teaching programs with our in-house ministers and create documentaries with stories of historical events and characters that have shaped our faith and our nation. We can create godly entertainment with music, films, and TV series that can capture the interest of a broader audience than we are reaching today and lead them on to discipleship with Jesus. We can utilize our global impact and share testimony stories from many nations and highlight what the Lord is doing all over the world, to reach the world.



I've asked Robert and Elizabeth Muren to take over the lead on this new network. Anyone who has seen our musicals or been exposed to other ministry from the Murens will know that they are one of the greatest blessings the Lord has sent us. They do everything with excellence, and this new Gospel Truth Network will be no exception.

We will be using Victory Channel's news and FlashPoint to stay up with current events from a Christian perspective. Truth & Liberty's daily program is being redesigned to be much more engaging and impactful. I will host a new daily program with Mike and Carrie Pickett called *Grace and Faith Today*. I'm really excited about this. We will be able to interview people and comment on current events in ways I've not been able to do with my daily broadcasts, which are recorded months in advance.

I'll be communicating many more details as this progresses, but I wanted to share with you what the Lord is leading me to do and ask you to agree with us in prayer for supernatural wisdom to get this done quickly and with the best excellence in the short amount of time available.

With the expansion of Charis, we are stretched to the max, but I've learned not to limit God (Ps. 78:41). And I've also learned to recognize the voice of the Lord. I truly believe this is the Lord's doing, and it's marvelous in our eyes.

The best is yet to come. Thanks for your prayers and agreement.

SUFFERING OF THE GODLY: IT'S NOT WHAT YOU THINK!

Let me start by saying the suffering of the godly does not include sickness, disease, poverty, lack, pain, depression, or mental torment. These are all things that Jesus paid the price for in our place (Is. 53:4–5) so that you and I don't have to suffer with them. If Jesus bore it, you don't have to.

However, there are still two types of suffering that you will deal with as a believer:

1. Persecution

Yes, and **all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.**

2 Timothy 3:12, NKJV, emphasis added

If you're going to follow the Lord, you're going to deal with persecution—people who don't like you, oppose you, talk about you, and will even betray you. You can't pray away persecution; you must learn how to process it and deal with it.

2. In the Flesh

Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for he who has **suffered in the flesh** has ceased from sin, that he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God.

1 Peter 4:1–2, NKJV, emphasis added

Suffering in the flesh is the willingness and discipline of our heart to follow the will of God when our flesh wants to do something else. We need to spend time with the Lord and find out what's on His heart for today and then just do what He tells us to do.

Jesus provided the right example in the Garden of Gethsemane when He said, "Father, if there's any other way, let this cup pass from Me. Nevertheless, not as I will but as You will." His flesh didn't want to die, be separated from the Father, or take on sin. But He said, "I'm going to follow Your will."

Has God ever asked you to do something and you've questioned Him, inquiring, "Why am I going here? Why am I serving here? Why are You leading me here?" **Just recognize that He is God, and you are not.** He knows the steps that you need to take for Him to promote you. It's going to require suffering in your flesh.

What is it that you value the most—an imperishable crown, or the temporary whims and pleasures of the flesh?

THE PICTURE OF THE “PERFECT MAN”

Do you know what it means to be “perfect”? Many people read Ephesians 4:11–13 and think that the fivefold ministry gifts of apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, and teacher were given to make us into a “perfect man” in the sense of being flawless. As long as we are in the flesh, we will never be flawless, so what does it mean to be a “perfect man” (Eph. 4:13)?

The Greek word translated “man” in this verse is the word *andro*. It is not referring to a person’s age but to the status of mature manhood. Greek scholars used this term to describe a “true” man, a man of courage, determination, and valiance. Paul used it to describe a responsible, trustworthy man who would fight for his family and nation. Such a man has grown past boyhood and attained manhood!

First Peter 5:10 says, “*But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.*” A “perfect man” is not one who is up and down and living on a “souler” coaster, but a stable and settled man.

So, other than heeding the fivefold ministry gifts and Scripture, how do we become perfected?

According to 1 Peter 5:10, there are “sufferings” that are part of the will of God. Here are three sufferings that you must master if you want to be the “perfect man” the Bible talks about:

#1 The Suffering of Resistance. Christians are not redeemed from resisting the devil. We must wholeheartedly resist his schemes that tempt us to disbelieve God! Don’t accept poverty, lack, sickness, or strife. Stand on the Word of God and resist (James 4:7)!

#2 The Suffering of Persecution. Second Timothy 3:12 promises that all who live godly in this life will suffer persecution. When we are persecuted and face outside pressures meant to lead us astray, we must rise above!

#3 The Suffering of Submission. The word *submission* is a military term. It means to arrange in rank or order. You must take your place under God to gain your authority over Satan! You are completely powerless until you submit yourself to Him. To fulfill God’s will, you must starve the lusts of your flesh just as the only perfect man did—Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 4:1–2)!

God has a perfect will for your life, but if you want to become the “perfect man” the Bible talks about, then you cannot disregard these three things!

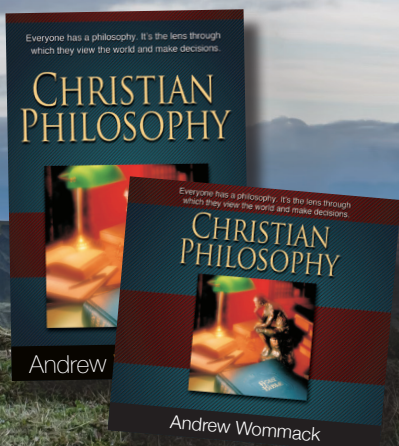
